15-MINUTE PICK-UP & DROP OFF POLICY

15 分钟接/送孩子政策

- 1. Secure a PCGS Car Pass Sticker 2019-2020 in order to get inside the school campus. Stick this on the left-hand side of the car's wind shield. Application form available upon request at the Business Office. 进入校园需要本校 2019-2020 學年度汽车贴纸。有意思的人可以到総務處要求申請表。
- 2. The first three car sticker is P100/sticker. The 4th and succeeding car pass sticker will cost P1,000 each. 每張车贴賣 P100 元(最多三張); 第四 張和後續的車貼紙每張賣一千菲幣。
- 3. Observe the 15-minute pick up & drop off policy. This means that all cars and persons are only allowed up to 15 minutes of staying time inside the campus. We encourage all parents and/or guardians to practice "KISS and GO." When you are reaching the loading/unloading area to drop off your child, KISS your child and off you GO. 父母或监护人在校园内最长停留时间为 15 分钟。大家要遵守本校 15 分钟接/送孩子政策
- 4. No parking for more than 15 minutes is allowed except the teaching and non-teaching personnel. 除了教師和工作人員外,不准停車超過15分鐘。
- 5. DO NOT PARK on the Pedestrian Lines. 步行线上 不准停车;不要挡住行人专用道。
- 6. EVERYBODY MUST use the pedestrian lanes to cross the street to/from the gym. This rule applies to all including students, parents and/or guardians and employees. 在校園内,大家必須用行人專用道過路
- 7. NO Blowing of horn inside the campus. 在校園內 不准吹喇叭
- 8. NO loud music. 在校園內不准嘈杂的音乐
- 9. Speed limit inside the campus is 10kph. 校园内車子的速度限制为每小時 10 公里(10kph)。

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS OF YOUR CHILD

- If you are a new parent, please submit a copy of your child's most recent results of chest x-ray and vaccination records.
- 2. If you are a returning parent, a certificate from your doctor to state that your child is physically fit with no health concerns/issues will suffice. Chest x-ray may not be necessary, if you have not been able to do so. Vaccination record is required for children below 13.
