7. CONTESTANTS

Membership Participants must be members of a National Federation which is affiliated to

the WT.

Divisions DAN: 1st Dan / Poom and higher, Kukkiwon Holder

K1: 2nd Kup (Red Belt) - 1st Kup (Black Tag)

K2: 6th Kup (Green Belt) - 3rd Kup (Red Tag)

K3: 10th Kup (White Belt) - 7th Kup (Green Tag)

Maximum 400 individual entries

Note: Kup divisions may be combined if less than 3 competitors in a division

Contestants can only enter a division once

Age categories are based on the year of birth. For example, if someone is 17 years old on the day of the competition but will be 18 before the end of the year (2018) then he/she shall participate in the category of U30 (18 - 30 years old).



8. A-CLASS DIVISION (DAN/POOM GRADES)

A Class: Competitors must be minimum 1st Dan/Poom grade & Kukkiwon or National holder.

METHOD OF COMPETITION

Cut-Off System will be used

1st Round: If there are 20 and over competitors in a division then the competition will start in this round. Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between.

2nd Round: The top 50% of the competitors with the highest scores from the 1st round will qualify for this 2nd round (including competitors with equal scores).

Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between

Final Round: The top 10 competitors (with the highest scores) from the 2nd round will qualify for this round. Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between

Final: Divisions may start in the final if there are 10 entrants or less. 11 entrants or more will start in the 2nd Round.

Compulsory Poomsae

All competitors must perform the set Poomsae and if they cannot they will be disqualified.

All compulsory Poomsae shall be drawn, set and announced by the organising committee 3 days before the competition.

10. A-CLASS FREESTYLE

- Freestyle Poomsae (Dan Grades only 12 -17yrs & 18yrs +)
- Individual Male
- Individual Female
- Mixed Pairs (One male & one female)
- **Team** (Two female & three male or two male & three female)

Freestyle Poomsae is the performance based on Taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.

Composition of Poomsae

- 1. Yeon-mu line shall be the choice of the competitor
- 2. Number of Poom: each performance shall be composite of 20 24 poom (composition shall be no more than 5 motions)
- 3. Music and choreography shall be the competitors choice
- 4. Performance shall be within the boundary line.
- 5. Performance shall be within 60 70 seconds.
- 6. The competitor must submit a plan of their freestyle performance on registration.
- 7. Music shall be supplied by the competitor; this must be in MP3 format and be done on registration by sending email to masterali@harrogatetaekwondo.co.uk
- 8. Music track must not contain any EXPLICIT lyrics

16. ARBITRATION

Procedure of Protest

Only the official head coach is allowed to protest to the Competition Director. This must be made within 10 minutes of the end of the contest. A protest fee of £75 will be payable immediately to the competition board. This will be refunded if the protest is accepted and won

SITUATIONS NOT COVERED BY THE RULES

Where any situation arises which is not covered by these rules, it shall be dealt with and decision given by the referee after consultation with the organizing committee.



17. JUDGES/ OFFICIALS

Judges:

Invitations shall be made by the **Judges Director Grand Master T.W. Shin 9th Dan (IR)** to selected judges who have passed the British Taekwondo Poomsae judges course or similar coaching course of a WT affiliated body. Please contact us if you would be interested in judging at the event.

All judges/officials will receive lunch and refreshments throughout the competition day and we will provide free accommodation for full time judges and all IR.

It is our request that all judges dress in appropriate attire (shirt and tie etc.) in accordance to WT / KTA (GBR) regulations.

The organisers shall try to ensure that regular breaks and rotation of judges is provided for all judges and officials.

18. FURTHER INFORMATION

Awards:

1st, 2nd and two 3rd and 4th place medals shall be awarded in each category. There shall also be 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall team trophies based on number of medals won by each team:

9pts Gold, 6pts Silver, 3pts Bronze/2pts Bronze

Dress:

A Class division: Competitors may compete wearing WT recognised Poomsae uniform.

Kup Divisions: Competitors may only compete wearing WT recognised uniform.

Any contestant wearing unofficial uniform will not be permitted to compete.

Jewellery is strictly not permitted.

Hall Rules: Only competitors and their coaches shall be admitted to the contest areas.

Spectators: Tickets are available on the door only. (Cash only)

- Adults/Children: £7.00 (5 year olds and older)
- 5 years and under will be admitted for free.

Spectators are requested to wear suitable footwear (no high heels) for a sport hall.

Officials: 2 coaches per team
