Note: Divisions may be combined if less than 3 competitors in a division

Maximum 280 individual entries

Contestants can only enter a division once

Age categories are based on the year of birth. For example, if someone is 17 years old on the day of the competition but will be 18 before the end of the year (2020) then he/she shall participate in the category of U30 (18 - 30 years old).

8. A-CLASS DIVISION (DAN/POOM GRADES)

A Class: Competitors must be minimum 1st Dan/Poom grade & Kukkiwon holder.

METHOD OF COMPETITION

Cut-Off System will be used

1st Round: If there are 20 and over competitors in a division then the competition will start in this round. Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between.

2nd Round: The top 50% of the competitors with the highest scores from the 1st round will qualify for this 2nd round (including competitors with equal scores).

Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between

Final Round: The top 8 competitors (with the highest scores) from the 2nd round will qualify for this round. Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between

Final: Divisions may start in the final if there are 8 entrants or less. 9 entrants or more will start in the 2nd Round.

Compulsory Poomsae

All competitors must perform the set Poomsae and if they cannot they will be disqualified.

All compulsory Poomsae shall be drawn, set and announced by the organising committee 3 days before the competition.

10. A-CLASS FREESTYLE

Freestyle Poomsae (Dan Grades only 12 -17yrs & 18yrs +)

Individual Male

Mixed Pairs (One male & one female)
Team (Two female & three male or two male & three female)

Freestyle Poomsae is the performance based on Taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.

Composition of Poomsae

- 1. Yeon-mu line shall be the choice of the competitor
- 2. Number of Poom: each performance shall be composite of 20 24 poom (composition shall be no more than 5 motions)
- 3. Music and choreography shall be the competitors choice
- 4. Performance shall be within the boundary line.
- 5. Performance shall be within 90 100 seconds.
- 6. The competitor must submit a plan of their freestyle performance on registration.
- 7. Music shall be supplied by the competitor; this must be in MP3 format and be done on registration.
- 8. Music track must not contain any EXPLICIT lyrics

Categories and Format

- a) Para competitors should please enter online and email your full details and para qualification. The categories will be determined on receipt of all the applications. (Eg P20, P33...)
- b) Competitors perform two different Poomsae in each round. If the same Poomsae is performed 0.3 will be deducted.
 - P10 Visual Impairments (Competitor's choice any Poomsae from Taegeuk 1, 2, 3... & higher)
 - P20 Intellectually Impaired (The coach is allowed to give the commands, competitor's choice)
 - P30 Physical Impairments (Compulsory Poomsae will be specified) (P31, P32) (P33, P34)
 - P40 Limb Deficiency (Competitor's choice Poomsae)
 - P50 Wheelchair Classes (Competitor's choice Poomsae)
 - P60 Deaf (Competitor's choice Poomsae)

16. ARBITRATION

Procedure of Protest

Only the official head coach is allowed to protest to the Competition Director. This must be made within 10 minutes of the end of the contest. A protest fee of £75 will be payable immediately to the competition board. This will be refunded if the protest is accepted and won

SITUATIONS NOT COVERED BY THE RULES

Where any situation arises which is not covered by these rules, it shall be dealt with and decision given by the referee after consultation with the organizing committee.

17. JUDGES/ OFFICIALS

Judges:

Invitations shall be made by the UTA (NI) Taekwondo Poomsae committee to selected judges who have passed the British Taekwondo Poomsae judges course or similar coaching course of a WT affiliated body. Please contact us if you would be interested in judging at the event.

All judges/officials will receive lunch and refreshments throughout the competition day.

It is our request that all judges dress in appropriate attire (shirt and tie etc.) in accordance to WT / UTA (NI) regulations.

The organisers shall try to ensure that regular breaks and rotation of judges is provided for all judges and officials.

18. FURTHER INFORMATION

Awards:

1st, 2nd and two 3rd place medals shall be awarded in each category. There shall also be 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall team trophies based on number of medals won by each team:

5pts Gold, 3pts Silver, 1pt Bronze

Dress:

A Class division: Competitors may compete wearing WT recognised Poomsae uniform.

Kup Divisions: Competitors may only compete wearing WT recognised uniform.

Any contestant wearing unofficial uniform will not be permitted to compete.

Jewellery is strictly not permitted.

Hall Rules: Only competitors and their coaches shall be admitted to the contest areas.

Spectators: £2 Entry Fee

Officials: 2 coaches per team
