Coaches are responsible for ensuring that their players' categories and entry details are correct as no refunds will be given if errors have been made.

Please note:

All information must be entered when registering players.

Any athlete remaining in the online system at the deadline will be responsible for paying the full entry fee even if that athlete does not compete.

Competition Rules

The cut-off system is to be used.

1st round: 20 or more competitors

2nd round: 9-19 competitors or 50% from 1st round.

Final: Top 8 competitors.

(Groups with 9 competitors may be a straight final). Organisers have the right to make any necessary changes.

Compulsory poomsae will be released on 11/02/2023

Competitors may be asked to perform any of the Poomsae from their set list in the order listed in the Compulsory Poomsae.

Two Poomsae will be performed in each round.

Awards

Awards will be presented to athletes who place 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places per category. Team trophies will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams.

Club awards:

1st place = 9 points

2nd place = 6 points

3rd place = 3 points

4th place = 2 points

Appeals

Any protests must be made by the Club Coach within 10 minutes of the end of that contest to the Judging director.

Bus
