The cut-off system will be used.

1 st Round	20 or more competitors
2 nd Round	9 - 19 competitors or 50% from 1 st round
Final Round*	Top 8 competitors

^{*}Groups with 9 competitors may go to a straight final.

Organisers have the right to make any necessary changes.

Compulsory Poomsae will be released on 10th February 2024.

Competitors may be asked to perform any of the Poomsae from their set list in the order listed in the Compulsory Poomsae.

Two Poomsae will be performed in each round.

Awards

Awards will be presented to athletes who place 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} and 4^{th} places per category. Team trophies will be presented for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place teams.

For the Team Trophy, points will be awarded as follows:

1 st Place	9 points
2 nd Place	6 points
3 rd Place	3 points
4 th Place	2 points

Appeals

Any protests must be made by the Club Coach within 10 minutes of the end of that contest to the Judging Director.
