Any changes to the entries on the day of the competition will incur a £30 admin fee per. If the competition cannot take place due to unforeseen circumstances out of the control of the organizer, the payment shall immediately be valid for the next physical taekwondo event the organizer creates.

Spectators: Tickets are available on the door only. (Cash only)

Adults: £10.00

Children: £5:00 (applies, to ages 6-16, under 5s

enter for free)

\*Spectators are requested to wear suitable footwear (no high heels) for a sport hall. Officials: 1 coach pass per team, for teams up to 5 competitors, 2 coach passes for 6 competitors+

Athletes must be members of a national federation affiliated to the WT. Proof of membership by means of a valid license, insurance and grade will be required at registration. All athletes/clubs must have their own insurance as Premier Taekwondo and any of its representatives will not be responsible for any injury cost.

Divisions DAN: 1st Dan / Poom and higher, Kukkiwon Holder (A Class: Competitors must be minimum 1st Dan/Poom grade & Kukkiwon or National holder.)

K1: 2nd Kup (Red Belt) - 1st Kup (Black Tag) K2: 6th Kup (Green Belt) - 3rd Kup (Red Tag) K3: 10th Kup (White Belt) - 7th Kup (Green Tag)

#### Maximum 400 total entries.

Kup divisions may be combined if less than 3 competitors in a division.















#### 6. METHOD OF COMPETITION

#### **Cut-Off System**

1st Round: If there are 21 competitors or more in a division then the competition will start in this round. Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one-minute rest period in between.

2nd Round: The top 50% of the competitors with the highest scores from the 1st round will qualify for this 2nd round (including competitors with equal scores).

Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one-minute rest period in between.

Final Round: The top 8 competitors (with the highest scores) from the 2nd round will qualify for this round. Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one-minute rest period in between.

Final: Divisions may start in the final if there are 10 entrants or less. 11 entrants or more will start in the 2nd Round.

#### Compulsory Poomsae

All competitors must perform the set Poomsae and if they cannot, they will be disqualified.

All compulsory Poomsae shall be drawn, set, and announced by the organizing through social media channels 3 days before the start of the competition.

#### 6.4 FAMILY POOMSAE

One parent, parents, or grandparents together with their child or children or grandchildren. The number of family members are unlimited. At least two generations are required for a family team. Examples: Father and son or daughter, mother, and father together with son and daughter, father with three sons, grandmother with grandchildren, grandfather, mother, and grandchildren. One participation per family is allowed. There is no age limit or graduation restriction for Family Poomsae. The Poomsae can be freely selected. All families go directly to finals. 2 poomsae must be performed, selected from the recognized poomsae

#### Procedure of Protest

Only the official head coach is allowed to protest to the Competition Director. This must be made within 10 minutes of the end of the contest. A protest fee of £75 will be payable immediately to the competition board. This will be refunded if the protest is accepted and won.
