7 Qualifications

7.1 Competitors

- (a) All competitors must be members of British Taekwondo or the WT affiliated Member National Federation for the country in which they reside. Members of British Taekwondo should enter their correct membership (M) number when registering. If a false number is entered, the player will fail the audit and fees will not be refunded.
- (b) Competitors should enter under their individual clubs and state the names of the club and their country at registration.
 - (i) Clubs may not combine or enter as an association or squad.
 - (ii) Teams and pairs can be from different clubs and will be entered as 'Mixed'. The results will not count towards medal points for the team trophies.
- (c) Coaches should ensure that all memberships are applied for and renewed in plenty of time to ensure that players are cleared to compete.

7.2 Coaches

- (a) One (1) coach will be accredited for every five (5) competitors entered and granted free admission. There can be a maximum of two (2) coaches per team.
- (b) The minimum age for a coach is 18 years.
- (c) Coaches will only be permitted at ringside in sportswear

7.3 Audits (coaches and competitors)

The deadline for submission of entries for audit is 10:00 p.m. on 11th June 2024
All players sent through audit must be paid for even if they withdraw.

8 Protests

Only the Head Coach will be allowed to protest to the Referee Director, immediately after the end of the contest in question. A fee of £75.00 will be paid for each protest lodged. The decision of the Referee Director is final.

- (e) The deadline for payments of entry fees is 18th June 2024. However, should the event reach its competitor limit all entry fees will become immediately payable to allow for competitors from the waiting list to be added should there be withdrawals.
- (f) Please ensure that all details entered online are correct.
- (g) All emails will be sent to Club Instructors and not individual players.
 - (i) Any corrections/amendments must be made by 10 days before the event.
 - (ii) The final player list will be emailed 7 days before the event.
 - (iii) Any subsequent changes before event will incur a £30 administration cost.
 - (iv) Please note all payments are non-refundable.
 - (v) Any changes to the entries on the day of the competition will incur a £30 admin fee.
 - (vi) If the competition cannot take place due to unforeseen circumstances out of the control of the organizer, the payment shall immediately be valid for the next physical Taekwondo event the organizer creates.

13.1 Information needed for online registration

For your online registration you will need to have the following information:

- (i) Coaches' details (maximum of 2 per club)
(Coaches of UK Competitors must have valid BT instructor's indemnity insurance for students to enter)
- (ii) Competitor's full name
- (iii) Competitor's correct date of birth
- (iv) Competitor's correct grade/belt
- (v) UK competitors only: Student's British Taekwondo membership (M) number.
(Competitor's membership must be current.)

13.2 Competition Rules & Method

- (h) World Taekwondo Competition Rules will be used.
- (i) WT-recognized uniform will be worn. Poomsae doboks are encouraged but, in the interests of promoting new clubs/competitors, standard WT doboks are allowed. Doboks must be appropriate to the division entered. Kup competitors will not be permitted to wear poom/dan doboks.
- (j) Age categories are based on year of birth, not the actual age at the time of the competition. See Sections 13.5 and 13.6.
- (k) Participating teams will be informed about the compulsory poomsae by e-mail on Friday 14th June 2024.

13.3 Method of competition Cut-Off System will be used.

| 1st Round | If there are 21 or more competitors in a division then the competition will start in this round.

Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between. |
| 2nd Round | The top 50% of the competitors with the highest scores from the 1st round will qualify for this 2nd round (including competitors with equal scores).

Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between. |
| Final Round | The top 8 competitors (with the highest scores) from the 2nd round will qualify for this round.

Two assigned compulsory Poomsae will be required to be performed with a one minute rest period in between. |
| Final | Divisions will start in the final if there are 10 entrants or less. |
| Compulsory Poomsae | All competitors must perform the compulsory Poomsae and if they cannot do so they will be disqualified.

All compulsory Poomsae shall be drawn, set and announced by the Organizing Committee 3 days before the competition. |

13.6 Para-taekwondo Poomsae

- (a) Para Competitors should please enter online (Male/Female) and email your full details and reasons for Para qualification.
The categories will be determined on receipt of all the applications.
- (b) Competitors perform two poomsae in each round.
- (c) If you require further information, please contact us.

13.7 Awards

- (a) Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places.
- (b) As the categories are Open Age and Open Belt, the judges will use their discretion and take into consideration age, disability and belt of the competitor.

13.8 Family Poomsae

- a) One parent, parents, or grandparents together with their child or children or grandchildren. The number of family members is unlimited. At least two generations are required for a family team. Examples: Father and son or daughter, mother and father together with son and daughter, father with three sons, grandmother with grandchildren, grandfather, mother and grandchildren. One participation per family is allowed. There is no age limit or graduation restriction for Family Poomsae. The Poomsae can be freely selected. **All families go directly to finals.** 2 poomsae must be performed, selected from the recognized poomsae
- b) Classification - family Poomsae (unlimited members, but minimum of)
- c) Grade - No Belt Restriction
- d) Selection – competitors choice of Poomsae
- e) Recognized Poomsae – Freedom of choice
- f) Division – One Family
- g) Age – No age limit

13.9 Situations not covered by the Rules

Where any situation arises, which is not covered by these rules, it shall be dealt with and the decision given by the Referee Director.

14 Venue Rules

14.1 Admission to the competition areas

Only the competitors and their coaches will be allowed to enter the competition area.

14.2 Coaches' age and dress code

Coaches must be at least 18 years old, hold British Taekwondo Instructor Insurance and must wear sportswear and sports shoes. Coaches may not wear Taekwondo uniform, sandals, flip-flops, short trousers or head wear whilst coaching, except for head coverings for religious or cultural reasons.

15 Liability

The Organizing Committee can decide to alter the competition. Any overseas contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in the United Kingdom.

16 Transport & accommodation

16.1 By bus

The nearest bus stop is the Cardiff Bridge bus stop. Approx 0.4 miles from the venue.

16.2 By coach

Located in Sophia Gardens, the National Sport Centre is also home to the National Express coach station. The venue can therefore be accessed by the National Express coach, bookable via www.nationalexpress.com

16.3 Arriving by train

Trains to Cardiff Central Station run regularly, connecting the city center to the rest of the UK. Cardiff Central Station is located within a very short walking distance several hotels in the city center and the National Sport Centre can be accessed via a short taxi or bus ride.

16.4 Arriving by air

The Sports Centre is located 28 minutes away from Cardiff Airport.

16.5 Parking
