7. CONTESTANTS

Membership Participants must be members of a National Federation which is affiliated to the WT.

Divisions Dan: 1st Dan / Poom and higher, Kukkiwon Holder

K1: 1st Kup (Black Tag) – 3rd Kup (Red Tag)
K2: 4th Kup (Blue Belt) – 6th Kup (Green Belt)
K3: 7th Kup (Green Tag) – 9th Kup (Yellow Tag)

K4: 10th Kup (White Belt)

Age categories are based on the year of birth. For example, if someone is 17 years old on the day of the competition but will be 18 before the end of the year (2025) then he/she shall participate in the category of 1st Senior's (18-35 years old).

Athletes can only enter one individual, one pair and one team.

8. SYSTEM OF COMPETITON

Cut-Off System.

<u>1st Round:</u> If there are over 20 competitors in a division then they will start in this round. Two poomsae will be required and may be performed with a 30 second rest period in between. One poomsae of the competitor's choice from the 1st Compulsory section of the table, and one from the 2nd Compulsory section of the table

2nd Round: top 50% of the competitors with the highest scores will qualify for this round. Two poomsae will be required and may be performed with a 30 second rest period in between. One poomsae of the competitor's choice from the 1st Compulsory section of the table, and one from the 2nd Compulsory section of the table

Final Round: The top 8 competitors (with the highest scores) from the 2nd round will qualify Two poomsae will be required and may be performed with a 30 second rest period in between. One poomsae of the competitor's choice from the 1st Compulsory section of the table, and one from the 2nd Compulsory section of the table

Final: Divisions may start in the final if there are 8 entrants or less

Elimination System.

Side by side tournament system may be used. This will be announced before the competition compulsory Poomsae are announced.

Two Athletes compete on the competition aera at the same time, Designated Poomsae from the compulsory list will be announced just before the athletes enter the Competition area. The winner moves forward to the next round.

A-class (black belt) contestants must perform a different set of two Poomsae for each round - preliminary, semi-final, final - of the competition.

Kup grade contestants may repeat the same two Poomsae in each round of the competition.

16. FAMILY DIVISIONS

Mixed Family Team: Must be Minimum of two generations

Poomsae: Free choice of Poomsae.

17. FURTHER INFORMATION

Awards: 1st, 2nd and 2 x 3rd Place medals shall be awarded in each category.

There shall also be 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place overall team trophies based on number of

medals won by each Team:

5pts Gold, 3pts Silver, 1pt Bronze, mixed pair and team points will divided between clubs.

Dress: Competitors may only compete wearing full WT uniform. Jewellery is strictly not permitted.

Hall Rules: Only competitors and their coaches shall be admitted to the contest areas.

Spectators: Admission

2 coaches per team

Protest: Only the official head coach is allowed to protest to the Competition Director. This must be made

within 10 minutes of the end of the contest. A protest fee of £75 GBP will be payable immediately to

the competition board. This will be refunded if the protest is accepted and won.
