5. Competitors/Coaches

All competitors and coaches from the UK must have a valid British Taekwondo Licence for the BT Audit. International competitors need to have a valid registration with their Countries Member National Association (MNA)

Competitors should enter under their individual clubs and state the names of the club and their country at registration. Clubs may

(a) One (1) coach will be accredited for every six (6) competitors entered and granted free admission. (ie. 2 coaches for 12 competitors, 3 coaches for 18 competitors etc.)

- (b) The minimum age for a coach is 18 years.
- (c) Coaches will only be permitted at ringside in sportswear or smart dress.

6. Competition entry

All competitors must hold a valid British Taekwondo Membership/Licence and participate at their own risk, no claim whatsoever can be made against the organizer or British Taekwondo. The organisers shall not accept responsibility for any damages, injuries, or losses sustained or incurred.

By entering the championships, you are agreeing to the taking of photographs and media images to be used to promote the Championships.

All freestyle competitors will need to sign a waiver on the day of the championships to accept full responsibility for any injury they may sustain. (Sorry no freestyle this event)

- a) Dan/Poom: Individuals, Pair, Team 1st Dan/Poom or higher
- b) K Divisions, K1 (1st 2nd Kup), K2 (6th 3rd Kup) & K3 (7th 10th Kup): individuals, Pair, Team.
- c) Para-Taekwondo Poomsae individual: From 9th Kup + higher, Both Kup and Dan grades.

7. Entry fee:

8. Admission

10. Competitors, Method of Competition.

All age categories (Dan/Poom, Kup grade 1st – 9th Kup, Para) are based on year of birth and not age at the competition. Therefore, their competition age will be their age on 31st December 2025.

Categories open from 9th Kup & above, provided all competitors know the compulsory Poomsae range.

Method of Competition

World Taekwondo Poomsae Competition Rules for Dan/Poom Grades and Single Elimination Tournament System side by side will be used Dan/Poom & K1 and Cut-off System for K2 & K3 Individual, Pair & Team event.

(Pair and Team event will perform one by one)

Single Tournament Knock Out System side by side for Dan/Poom and K1 Division;

Cut-off System will be used for K2 & K3 Divisions.

Uniform

WT- Recognised standard uniform and WT Poomsae competition uniform are allowed.

Awards

1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th place awards shall be given for each category.

Individual Awards will be presented immediately after the category final with photographs at the podium area.

Club:

1st place = 9 points, 2nd = 6 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points

Team awards will be calculated over the day and awards will be presented at the end of the Championships on the day.

11. Protests

Any protests must be made by the Club Head Coach on completion of "the Official Protest form" within 10 minutes of the end of that contest to the Judging Director: The protest fee is £75 (refunded if protest is won). The decision of the Referee Director is final.

How do you watch two at once?

1. Judges' Positioning:

Judges can observe both athletes clearly from multiple angles. Typically, the referees sit in front of the competitors to ensure they can see all movements and compare performances side by side.

2. Focus on Key Movements:

Judges need to focus on specific key movements that are critical to scoring (e.g., major mistakes, stances, balance,). If two players perform, on synchronize major moves, making it easier to compare precision, accuracy, but more important Speed and Power, Rhythm and Tempo and Expression of Energy & Volume of Movement.

3. Side-by-Side Visual Layout:

In certain high-level competitions or for the purpose of analysis, the two performances may be recorded. This helps referees or audiences compare the execution and timing more closely.

4. Evaluation Criteria:

Judges focus on core criteria such as accuracy, power, speed, and expression. Judges needs to pick out these aspects even in a side-by-side performance, they ensure both players receive equal attention.

5. Divided Attention:

Although challenging, referees should learn to split their attention between two competitors during synchronized performances, especially in if player are in different timing.
