Payment is required a week after applying online. Please only register athletes you are sure will compete, and remove any names not competing, to give other clubs opportunity to register their athletes. The list will be reviewed weekly to ensure this is managed. We encourage clubs to adhere to this, as filling up spaces, not only discourage other clubs from registering, but have an adverse impact on the overall planning of the event.













10. CONTESTANTS

Membership: Participants must be members of the World Taekwondo MNA Competitors must enter the division that reflects their grade on the day of the competition. Any instances of competitors competing in an incorrect grade will be investigated and may results in disqualification form the competition, with possible further sanctions on the instructor and club. Age categories are based on the year of birth. For example, if a player is 17 years old on the day of the competition but will turn 18 before the end of the calendar year (2025) then the player will participate in the U30 category (18 – 30 years old).

All competitors will compete in their 2024 age division. Players can enter a maximum of one pair and one team

11. SYSTEM OF COMPETITION

Cut-Off System will be used; all divisions will have a maximum of 3 rounds (semi-final & final)

1st Round: 20 or more competitors.

2nd Round: 9-19 competitors or 50% from 1st Round.

Final: Top 8 Competitors:

Final: Divisions may start in the final if there are 9 entrants or less

Organisers have the right to make any necessary changes.

- Performances shall be 90 100 seconds.
- Music to be supplied by competitors, on the day of the competition, in MP3 format.
- Music cannot be supplied through streaming services or YouTube.
- Music cannot contain any lyrics.

- A-class (black belt) contestants must perform a different set of two Poomsae for each round; preliminary, semi-final, final of the competition.
- Competitor has been assigned a para-Taekwondo sport class and class sport status.
- WT classification is not required for this event, however it is expected clubs will enter athletes into the appropriate sport class.

20. FURTHER INFORMATION

Awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th Place medals shall be awarded in each category.

There shall also be 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place overall team trophies based on number of medals won by each Team:

5pts Gold, 3pts Silver, 1pt Bronze

Dress: permitted: Competitors may only compete wearing full WT uniform. (Poomsae Dobok or Kukkiwon style Dobok are permitted) **Jewellery is strictly not permitted**

Hall Rules: Only competitors and their coaches shall be admitted to the contest areas.

Only one (1) coach, one (1) athlete and one (1) officially licenced Medical Doctor are allowed to enter the Field of Play with their official accreditation. The OC has the right to refuse participants access to the Field of Play.

One (1) coach will be accredited for every five (5) players and will gain free entry to the competition. Maximum five (5) coaches per team will be granted free entry.

Any additional coaches can be registered at the cost of £10.00 per coach. All coaches are permitted to wear sportswear courtside.

Spectators: Admission fee

Adults £10 (16 years and above) Children £7 (under 5 years free)

Protest:

Only the official head coach is allowed to protest to the Competition Director. This must be made within 10 minutes of the end of the contest. A protest fee of £75 will be payable immediately to the competition board. This will be refunded if the protest is accepted and won.
