Family Poomsae

The Family Poomsae event will be split into 2 groups. Please refer to the table below to ensure you enter yourself into the correct category:

Category	Belt Range
Mixed Family	Families can have a combined team of Kup & Dan competitors
Dan Family	Families consist of Dan Competitors only



Para Categories

Para Categories are divided into Male & Female, Kup & Dan categories.

Kup Grades: Competitors may repeat the same 2 Poomsae within each round.

Dan Grades: For all Sport Classes there is a free choice to athletes to choose one Poomsae from Group 1 and one Poomsae from Group 2, for each round from Individual divisions.

World Taekwondo classification is not required for this event. However, clubs are expected to enter competitors into the appropriate Sport Class. Clubs must provide the Competition Manager with written evidence from a medical professional that shows that an entry is appropriate for the Sport Class. This must be made by Friday 3rd October.

Method of Competition

Cut-Off System will be used.

Compulsory Poomsae will be drawn for all Dan and K1 divisions. K2, K3 and other Para divisions must perform poomsae from within the specific ranges.

Two Poomsae will be required to be performed in each round. Poomsae cannot be repeated in the same round.

1st Round: If there are 20 or more competitors in a division then the competition will start in this round.

2nd Round: The top 50% of the competitors with the highest scores from the 1st round will qualify for this 2nd round (including competitors with equal scores).

Note: All K2 & K3 divisions with 10 or more competitors will start from this round. This will apply even if there are over 20 competitors in the division.

Final Round: The top 8 competitors (with the highest scores) from the 2nd round will qualify for this round.

Divisions will start in the final if there are 9 competitors or less (Dan Divisions).
Divisions will start in the final if there are 10 competitors or less (Kup Divisions).

All competitors must perform the Compulsory Poomsae and if they cannot do so they will be disqualified.

All compulsory Poomsae shall be drawn and announced by the Organising Committee 3 days before the competition.

Coaches

Coaches must hold a valid British Taekwondo Instructor Membership.

The minimum age for a coach is 18 years old. Coaches passes will only be issued if the above criteria are met.

All coaches must register online prior to the deadline date. Once this deadline has passed, no further coaches can be added. All coach information must be entered online through the recognised entry system.

A ratio of 1 coach for every 5 players entered will be granted free entry, up to a maximum of 5 coaches. Additional coaches can be registered for a fee (£25 per coach).

Competition Rules

World Taekwondo Competition Rules will be used, implemented following the British Taekwondo Sanctioned Poomsae Championships Policy.

Uniforms

WT Recognised uniforms to be worn. Poomsae Doboks are encouraged for Dan categories. But, in the interests of promoting new clubs/competitors, standard WT Doboks are allowed. Doboks must be appropriate to the division entered. Kup competitors will not be permitted to wear Poom/Dan Doboks.

Competitors & Coaches

All participants (athletes and coaches) must have valid British Taekwondo membership.

Anyone removed from the event system due to a lapsed membership or any other reason will not be permitted to participate/coach. Entry fees cannot be refunded in this case.

Coaches must bring and show photo identification at registration to collect coaches' passes and team packs and must attend in person.

Jewellery & Piercings

All jewellery and piercings must be removed before athletes arrive at the inspection desk to prevent delays. Athletes may miss or forfeit their match if they cannot meet competition rules.

Protests

Any protests must be promptly presented to the Chief Referee with the accompanying fee (£75) in order to be heard. If successful, the fee will be returned. If the protest is rejected then the fee will not be refunded.

Full details can be found within British Taekwondo's policy documents.

Awards

Awards will be presented to athletes who place 1st, 2nd, 2 x 3rd places per category. Team trophies will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams.

1st Place	9 points
2nd Place	6 points
3rd Place	3 points
4th Place	2 points

Important notes for coaches

Coaches must ensure that the email address used to register is the same email address that they can be contacted on for updates.

Coaches are responsible for ensuring that their players' categories and entry details are correct as no refunds will be given if errors have been made.

All information must be entered when registering players.

The club of any athlete remaining in the online system at the deadline will be responsible for paying the full entry fee even if that athlete does not compete.

Venue Rules

Only the competitors and registered coaches of the current and the next division to compete will be allowed to enter the competition area.

Please all spectators, teams, coaches and athletes, respect the venue as it is a multi-use space.

There will be a separate warm up area available. Please use this space to warm up. Any practice taking place in corridors, or areas of venue where it is NOT permitted will be asked to move.

Competitors should use changing rooms for changing and not change in the spectator area.

Liability

The Organising Committee can decide to alter the competition. The Organising Committee does not take liability for any items that are lost. Competitors enter at their own risk.

The OC does not take any responsibility for competitors who miss their match due to being in the designated warm up area.

Any overseas contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in the United Kingdom.

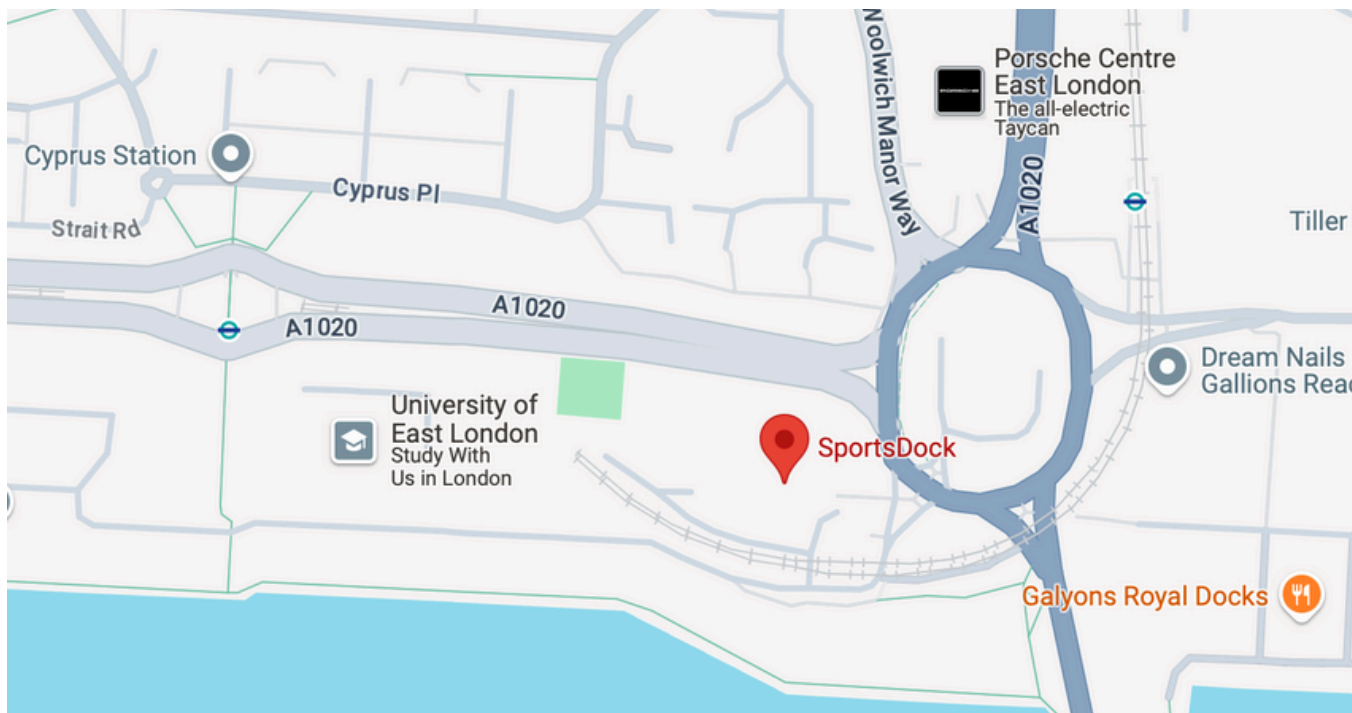
Travel
