



# Li-FT<sup>®</sup> Ink Removal Information

## What is it?

Li-FT<sup>®</sup> is a unique saline removal formula like no other in the world made by Li Pigments. No chemicals, no acids just all-natural ingredients, salt and citrus fruit extracts. It is made in a state of the art licensed and inspected manufacturing lab. Li-FT<sup>®</sup> went through extensive testing by an independent lab for safety. With proper aftercare, it has the ability to lighten bad permanent makeup, microblading and body tattoos.

## How does it work?

Science! In short, saline removal uses the power of osmosis to lift pigment molecules up and out of the skin. The solution is placed into the dermis with a group of needles, manual or by machine. Similar to how the unwanted pigment was implanted in the first place.

The real magic is in the healing process. During that time, the unwanted pigments will rise to the surface of the skin and exit in the form of a scab. This is a great sign! We want scabs!

In some cases, pigment may appear darker, this is a good sign as well. That means it is coming to the surface.

## What can I expect?

As with any pigment removal process, it takes patience and usually requires multiple sessions.

Expect visible and wanted results in 2-5 sessions.

Please be patient and give the process a fair chance to work.

Sessions must be done 8 weeks apart at minimum, no exceptions.

How many sessions needed will depend on factors such as; how saturated the pigment is,

how deep it was implanted, and how much pigment needs to be removed for the desired result.

Results are highly dependent on client aftercare! If you are not able to commit to aftercare,

this may not be the pigment removal solution for you.

Please refer to the aftercare instructions before committing to this service.

## **Emergency Li-FT®**

If you had bad permanent makeup or body art, an emergency Li-FT<sup>®</sup> session is available and MUST be done within 48 hours of the appointment. After the 48-hour mark, the skin has begun the healing process and the emergency window has closed. If you are past the 48-hour mark, you will need to wait the full 6-8 weeks to come in and do a regular Li-FT<sup>®</sup> session. Emergency Li-FT<sup>®</sup> sessions do not penetrate the skin again. It is a soak with the solution while the skin is still open in order to assist pigment to not settle into the dermis. If you need this service, please contact Shelly immediately as soon as you made your decision.

## Am I a candidate for Li-FT<sup>®</sup>?

If you have any of the following contraindications, you are NOT a candidate for this service:

- Any type of skin irritation in service area including sun burn/ tan
- Pregnant or breastfeeding
- Currently undergoing chemotherapy
- Cannot commit to aftercare instructions
- Allergic to salt, citrus fruits, aloe or vitamin E

- No facials 2 weeks prior
- No Botox or fillers 2 weeks prior
- No fish oil, aspirin prior
- No alcohol 24 hours prior
- No Accutane 1 year prior
- No retinols 30 days prior
