Before Mattan Torah The world couldn't be affected, After Mattan Torah, Higher and lower connected.



After Mattan Torah,
Hashem initiated and gifted,
"I placed my essence in the Torah"
Through that, the Yidden were uplifted.

Before Mattan Torah,
There's an advantage too,

The Yidden were bound to Torah,
