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Each of Yaakov's children were assigned a place around his coffin, To carry him to Eretz Yisrael, his final destination. Yosef and Levi were the exception, Since Yosef was a king and Levi's children would carry the Aron in a future generation.

To carry their father's coffin was a Mitzvah obligation, Especially for Yosef who took an oath to bury his father out of Mitzrayim. Therefore Menashe and Efraim were their Shluchim, To take their place in the funeral procession.

We understand that Menashe could replace his father, To understand the connection between Levi and Yosef's son, Efraim, we need to look deeper. Moshe Rabeinu who is a descendant of Kehos, the son of Levi, and the redeemer, Was the one to get the coffin of Yosef out of the Nile River.

The difference between Yaakov's coffin and Yosef's coffin is clear to see, Yaakov's coffin represented the beginning of the exile and the slavery. While Yosef's coffin represented the beginning of redemption and victory! Which fits the identities of both Yosef and Shevet Levi.
