The Service of the Jewish Slave vs the Service of the Gentile Slave

This week's Torah-portion speaks of giving '*severance*' to a slave when he is set free. However, this law applies only to a *Jewish Slave/Maidservant*, and not to a *Gentile* one. As a matter-a-fact, according to the Torah, one is not allowed to free a *Gentile Slave*, unless his doing so is for the sake of a mitzvah! Why?!

Let us discuss this on the *Esoteric Level*, in which we are speaking but of the different levels of a Jew in their service G-d:

The Jewish Slave/Maidservant represents one's service to G-d, in which they are dealing <u>with</u>, and refining their <u>Emotions</u>. That one's emotions of Love, Fear, Awe, Compassion, Kindness, Justice, etc. should be only to that which have spiritual true values, and not self-centered values.

The Gentile Slave represents the service of one who on their own is wanted to be completely free from responsibility and free from accountability. Thus, the service of the Gentile Slave must be one of total Obedience, which is absolute Self-negation. The Gentile Slave's service is due <u>only</u> out of Fear of his Master.

Therefore, while the service of the *Gentile Slave* is far inferior to that of the *Jewish Slave/Maidservant*, nevertheless, it has far greater in the virtue of its *self-negation* to G-d and to G-d's *Supernal Will*. Regardless of the service of the *Jewish Slave* and *Maidservant*, in which *slave* and *maidservant* are synonymous with *obedience* and *self-negation*, nevertheless, being that the *Jewish Slave/Maidservant* serve with *feelings*, *their feelings*, hence, their service to G-d is mixed with a feeling of *self*, and hence, lacks in its absolute *self-negation* and *obedience*. Not so, the service of the *Gentile Slave*, which has *no* feelings of the *slave* involved, but has only total *obedience* and *self-negation*.

This is the reason why the service of the *Jewish Slave/Maidservant* are of which to be freed, being that the whole point of their service is to *ascend* and to *leave* their *finite Service of Human Emotions* into the far higher *Service of Human Intellects*. However, the service of the *Gentile Service*, that of *absolute* pure *obedience* and *self-negation*, is *infinite*, and hence, not a service to ever need to *leave* from, for there is nothing higher to which to *ascend*.

This is also the reason why the *Gentile Slave* does not receive the *ha'anokah*, severance pay, because mystically speaking, the *Severance Package* for completing the *Service of Human <u>Emotions</u>* is the gift of the revelation of *Human Intellects*. However, in the *Gentile Slave's* service of *obedience* and *self-negation*, the 'gift' of revelation of *Human Intellect* is but the interference of the egotistical experience of, "*I think….*" Rather, the *Gentile Slave's Intellectual* experience of studying Torah is that of the, "*The words that <u>G-d</u> speaks through my voice box," self-negation* and *obedience*!

Well then, why do the *Esoteric Teachings* see the general service of Israel to be one of the <u>Jewish</u> Slave/ Maidservant, when it is <u>finite</u>, and that of the service of the <u>Gentile Slave</u>, which is <u>infinite</u>?!

The answer is that ultimately, G-d wants us to serve Him with <u>both</u>, with <u>self-negation obedience and</u> with using the *Faculties* (*Intellects* and *Emotions*) of Our Soul. In which the obedience and <u>self-negation</u> permeate and saturate our *Intellects* and *Emotions*. It does not suffice to serve G-d with <u>only</u> obedience and <u>self negation</u>, but rather, we are to serve G-d with pleasure, understanding, and feelings, as well.
