IN THE PARSHA:	
Hashem commanded בני ישראל to bring a on the 1st anniversary of יציאת מצרים.	
In response to the plea from people who were טמא, Hashem also gave the פטח שני 6 מצוה. From	
now on, whoever didn't bring the ייד אייר would bring one on ייד אייר.	
רשייי explains that although this story should have been written in the of	
חומש במדבר, it was placed out of (chronological) order, because the fact that in all their 40 years	
in the מדבר they only brought one קרבן פסח is embarrassing for בני ישראל.	
QUESTION:	
Before מצרים left מצרים, they had already been told that they would only bring the קרבן פסח	
every year once they entered	
Since they were not commanded to bring it until then, they were not even allowed to.	
So, why is it shameful that they didn't bring it during the 40 years in the מדבר?	
Answer:	
In the story of פסח שני we see that when even when a group of people sincerely	
asked to bring the קרבן פסח, Hashem gave them a chance to do it.	
Certainly, if בני ישראל would have asked to bring the מדבר all those years in the מדבר,	
Hashem would have granted their request.	
It is shameful that they didn't bring the קרבן פסח all the years in the מדבר, because if they had	
sincerely to bring it, Hashem would have given them the opportunity to do so.	
LIFE Lesson:	
We must sincerely ask Hashem to send us מצוות so we could properly fulfill all the מצוות.
