IN THE PARSHA:

After the משה רבנו חטא, Hashem's told משה רבנו that He was so angry, He wanted to immediately destroy the entire Jewish people.

משה responded: לָמָה, הֹי, יֶחֱרֶה אַפְּּךְ בְּעַמֶּךְ - Hashem, why should you be so angry at your people? באייי explains that משה רבנו was not saying that the people who sinned shouldn't be punished. Rather, משה was saying that די shouldn't immediately destroy the entire Jewish people out of anger at the עבודה זרה זרה וtself.

משה said that a חכם, a _____ person, is only jealous of another חכם, and a , _____ person, is only jealous of another גבור.

Since the עגל הזהב is neither wise nor strong, Hashem should not be "_____" that people worshipped it.

QUESTION:

עבודה זרה does not have **any** powers or qualities.

Why did משה specifically say that Hashem is **wise** and **strong**, and the אגל is not?

ANSWER:

One of the things that angered יד so much about the ערב רב was the ערב רב saying "these are your gods who brought you up from מצרים", when, of course, <u>די</u> had taken them out of מצרים.

_____ involved Hashem's "wisdom" and "strength".

- **▶ Wisdom** to know **how** to do it.
- > **Strength** to actually be **able** to do it.

Since איז was angry that they said that the עגל had taken them out of מצרים, which required specifically wisdom and strength, משה said איז shouldn't be jealous and angry, since, in fact, the had neither of those qualities.

Further discussion:

While this explains why Hashem should not be "jealous" of the ענל itself, how does this explain why Hashem should not be angry at the people who worshipped the ענל?
