BH. SICHA SHEMINI VOL 17 - DEBATE between MOSHE & AHARON:

MOSHE	AARON
All sacrifices should've been eaten	"Sacrifices of the MOMENT" should be eaten
Temple inauguration overrides mourning	"Sacrifices of Generations" should be burnt

Aaron explains his position. "Moshe heard & it pleased him" (he agreed)

TALMUD	RASHI
He admitted & wasn't bashful to say	He admitted & wasn't bashful to say
"I haven't heard this law"	"I haven't heard this law"
Rather, he said "I heard & forgot"	

RASHI'S INTENT:

COMMENTARIES on RASHI	THE REBBE
Same as the TALMUD	Means what he says
Moses had FORGOTTEN this law	Moses never heard this law

Why does RASHI differ from TALMUD:

- A. It's not a praise to say Moses didn't lie
- B. If he heard & forgot, what's the meaning "& it pleased him"

Further Proof to Rebbe's approach:

RASHI in MATOS: 3 places Moses got angry & forgot law:

- 1. Eating sacrifice while in mourning (our discussion here)
- 2. Law of Koshering Midyanaite vessels (Matos)
- 3. Hitting the rock

Why wait until Matos to mention this?

Because here it isn't obvious, since it was primarily a "logical" debate (not an argument on what G-d had said)

MOSHE	AARON
All sacrifices should've been eaten	"Sacrifices of the MOMENT" should be eaten
Temple inauguration overrides mourning	"Sacrifices of Generations" should be burnt

Why they took their positions:

TRUTH – "Companion to the King"	KINDNESS – "Companion to the Bride"
Consistent at all times	People aren't consistent at all times
Death & impurity don't affect	Death & impurity are real

Moses accepted it - there's value to KINDNESS from TRUTH'S perspective:

Even a limited measure of TRUTH (infinity) is a reflection of absolute truth (& true infinity)

"...with all YOUR might"

"Gold created for Temple"

Fire: analogous of Divine soul

Moses agreed – Real TRUTH is actually about KINDNESS:

Purpose of HEAVEN is to reflect truth here on EARTH, with all its imperfections & limitations
