In the Parsha:
Hashem was going to bring a to the world, and He commanded to
build a, in which he would be safe.
It took תיבה years to build the תיבה.
QUESTION:
Why did it take מ so long to build the תיבה? Why didn't he finish it sooner?
Answer:
Hashem did not only tell מבול in order to him from the תיבה.
He could have saved מבול in other ways.
Rather, Hashem told נח to build the תיבה, so that people would be curious about
what he was doing, and when they asked, he would warn them about the מבול, in
the hope that they would do
In fact, Hashem told מיבה to build the תיבה by, so it would take more
time, and give people more of a chance to do תשובה.
(When we consider that he built the תיבה all by himself, it's amazing that he
completed it in only 120 years!)
Further discussion:
Hashem said עשה לד תיבת גוי had to build the תיבה by himself, from material belonging to him.
material belonging to <u>nam</u> . Hashem said חג הסוכות <u>תעשה לד</u> , and yet, we can have someone <u>else</u> build
our Sukkah for us, and fulfill the Mitzvah in someone <b>else's</b> Sukkah. Why the difference?
