THE BACKGROUND:
Once, the non-Jewish rulers of ארץ ישראל forbade the Jewish people to read from the תורה, unde

Since the decree was only against reading תמשה חומשי תורה, they began reading from נביאים ever
week, choosing a part that shares a connection to that week's פרשה.
(We still read these parts of the בראה every week after reading the פרשה. It is called).
THE PARSHA AND THE HAFTARA:
What is the connection between and its הפטרה?
1) In ברשת בלק we learn about בלק inviting to curse the Jewish people, and how
was forced to tell בלק that Hashem was not allowing him to do this.
In the מיכה הנביא, we learn about מיכה הנביא reminding the Jewish people about
how Hashem protected the Jewish people from בלעם and בלק.
2) In פרשת בלק the Jewish people are just about to enter ארץ ישראל.
In the ביא speaks about the final preparations for the future
·
3) At the very end of פרשת בלק we learn about how פינחס had מסירת נפש to do what had to
be done for the sake of Hashem, without any other considerations.
In the beginning of the הפטרה (which we read closest to the end of the
פרשה) we learn about the Jewish people having perfect only in
Hashem, without relying on anyone or anything else.
