Biblical Basis for View:	Exodus	Exodus/Leviticus	Leviticus
Application:	Intention matters	Intention matters	Intention doesn't matter
When is it permitted:	ONLY for actual holiday food prep	When there's some need for YT, even not directly food	Even for no reason
Example of difference:	Only for one's own meal; (not if fasting)	Also for others	Even non-kosher
Cooking more than need: (Or slaughtering large animal)	NO	YES	YES
Cooking for the next day	NO	NO	YES
Cooking for aroma	NO	YES	YES
Carrying non food items (e.g. tallis, siddur, shoes, friend's book)	NO	IF NEEDED TODAY	YES
Carrying keys	NO	THOSE NEEDED	YES
Food prep as a job	NO	NO	YES
