| Before, we sell our גוי to a גוי. Together with the חמץ, we also sell any כלים |

| We כלים that we buy from a כלים, because they were in the |
| possession of the גוי, where it is possible that he use it for non-Kosher food. |
| Therefore, when they come into the holy possession of a Jew, we טובל it before using it. |
| However, on כלים, even if the גוי were sold to the גוי, practically speaking, since the גוי |
| does not access the כלים, it isn't likely at all that the גוי use it. |
| Therefore, there is no need to כלים after פסח. |
