In the Parsha:
says that when the Jewish people will enter ארץ ישראל, and they will serve די, properly,
they will be with many blessings, including:
לא תִּהְיֶה מְשַׁכֵּלָה וַעֲקָרָה, בְּאַרְצֶּךְ – "no woman in your land will miscarry or be barren",
אָת-מִסְפַּר יָמֶידּ, אֲמֵלֵא – "I will fill the number of your days".
Answer / Life Lesson:
Every תורה in מיורה has many "layers" of meaning, and a in serving די.
עבודה A person might see that that there is no continuity to his עבודה,
it doesn't last חס ושלום, (like a woman who doesn't have children).
דְּאַרְעֶּדְּ״ – This can be a result of the fact that he only served די because <u>he wanted</u> to,
not because רצון told him to (the word ארץ is similar to the word רצון,). This can
lead מצוות to a point where he is only willing to do מצוות that he enjoys, and not others.
יאָת-מִסְפַּר יָמֶידּ, אֲמֵלֵא״ - To prevent this from happening, a person must remember that י־
gives every single one of us a specific mission to accomplish in this world, and a specific
amount of in which to complete this mission.
When a person will focus on the mission that <u>r</u> gave us, he will not be distracted or
limited by what he himself wants. Rather, he will make sure to fill his days with
serving די, and not distracted or limited by what he himself wants.
