Before Yaakov passed away, He called to his sons and did say, "What will happen in the end of days I will tell you," But from him, the Divine presence withdrew.

To reveal when Moshiach would arrive was Yaakov's intention, But how would this information be beneficial to his children? Seemingly the opposite is true, they would feel blue, If they knew that for a few thousand years, Moshiach's arrival wasn't due.

There are two opinions about what did happen, When Yaakov wanted to make this revelation. 1. From him the knowledge was also hidden.

2. Yaakov just did not tell his children because the Divine presence left him.

To a chariot who follows its rider, Yaakov does compare, His will was the will of Hashem it is clear. Revealing and withholding are opposite approaches it is true, But each one has an advantage for serving Hakadosh Baruch Hu.
