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The Torah lists 69 of Yaakov's children and grandchildren,

But the Torah says that the total number of people were seventy,
To answer who is the one that completed the count, there are opinions three.

Pirkei D'Rabbi Eliezer says that it was Hakadosh Baruch Hu, Other Mefarshim say that it was Yaakov Avinu. Rashi says that it was Yocheved, a brand new baby, Who was born in the walls of the city.

Going down to Mitzrayim and the slavery was a preparation,
To receive the Torah on the Sinai mountain,
Which would impact the seventy nations of humanity,
And the Yidden who had 70 Zekanim who were so great and holy.

At Matan Torah, the barrier between heaven and earth was taken away, "I am Hashem, your G-d, who took you out of Mitzrayim," Hashem did say.

Every Jew for all time would have the ability to feel and know,

That Hashem is Elokecha, your personal life force to give you your energy wherever you go.

In order for that to happen, the spark of Yaakov Avinu,
