UNITY IN THE מײנים:

We know that the מײנים די represent different type of Jews who might excel in:

- Study of Torah – the _ _ _ _ _
- Performance of good deeds – the _ _ _ _ _
- Both, the study of Torah and the performance of good deeds – the _ _ _ _ _
- Neither of the above – the _ _ _ _ _.

We bring them all together, to show that we are **all** one people, united as **one**.

חסידות explains that each of the מײנים די themselves also represents _____, oneness.

UNITY IN THE LULAV:

The Lulav branch is made up of many individual leaves that are tightly **attached to each other** (and its stem). In fact, each of these leaves themselves are made up of 2 leaves that are attached on one end.

UNITY IN THE HADAS:

The leaves on the Hadasim grow in groups, each set of 3 leaves growing **together**, from the same part of the stem.

UNITY IN THE ARAVOS:

The branches of the Aravos grow close **together**, in bunches.

UNITY IN THE ESROG:

The Esrog stays on the tree throughout the year, growing from (and thereby bringing **together**) all the different seasons.
