### In the Parsha:

## **Question:**

What is the special connection between this מצוה and יציאת מצרים?

#### Answer:

When the Jewish people were in atrible situation, that one might think that they would not be able to get out.

- Physically, מצרים was so secure, that even a single slave could not \_\_\_\_\_.
- Spiritually, the Jewish people had sunk to the 49<sup>th</sup> level of טומאה.

With the ברית מילה, a Jew enters a covenant with הי, making a commitment to be connected to Him no matter what, <u>even when it seems like it doesn't make sense</u> to do it.

When the Jews made this commitment to הי, He Himself freed them from מצרים, even <u>if it didn't</u> <u>make sense</u>.

## Life Lesson:

Every day we have to experience our own spiritual \_\_\_\_\_\_

Sometimes, a person might think they are not able to break free of their personal "מערים".

- > Physically, he might feel like they are too tired.
- > Spiritually, he might feel that he is not capable of taking the "\_\_\_\_\_" to the next level.

Like the Jews in מצרים, we must know that even if it seems unlikely, we can break through all these limitations, with an absolute commitment to do what r wants.
