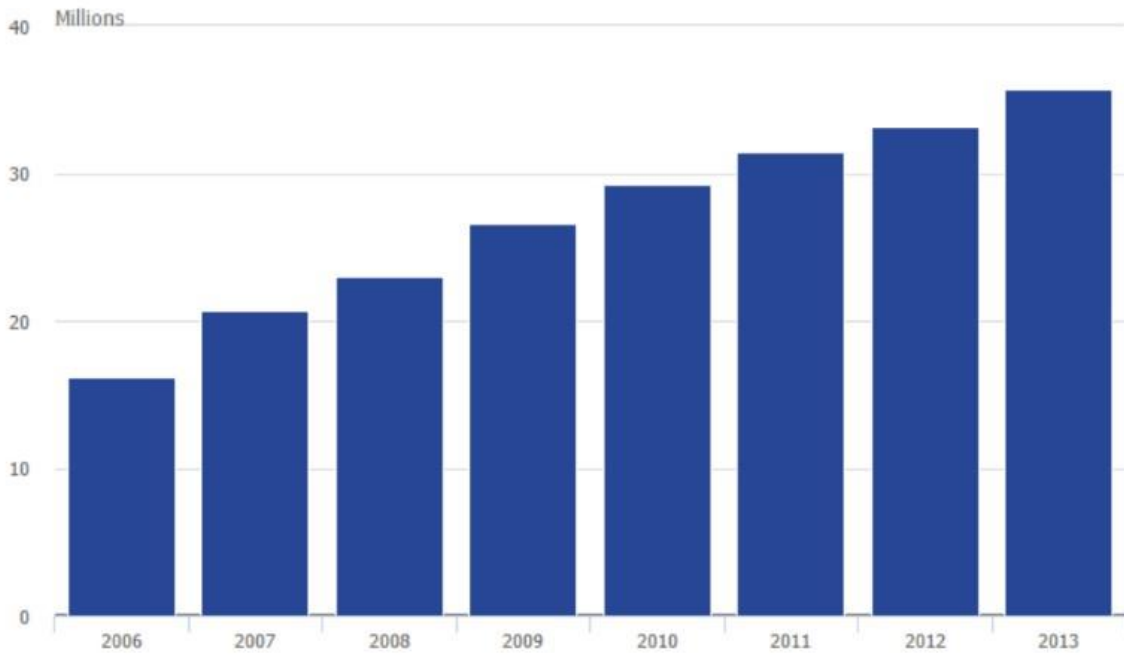

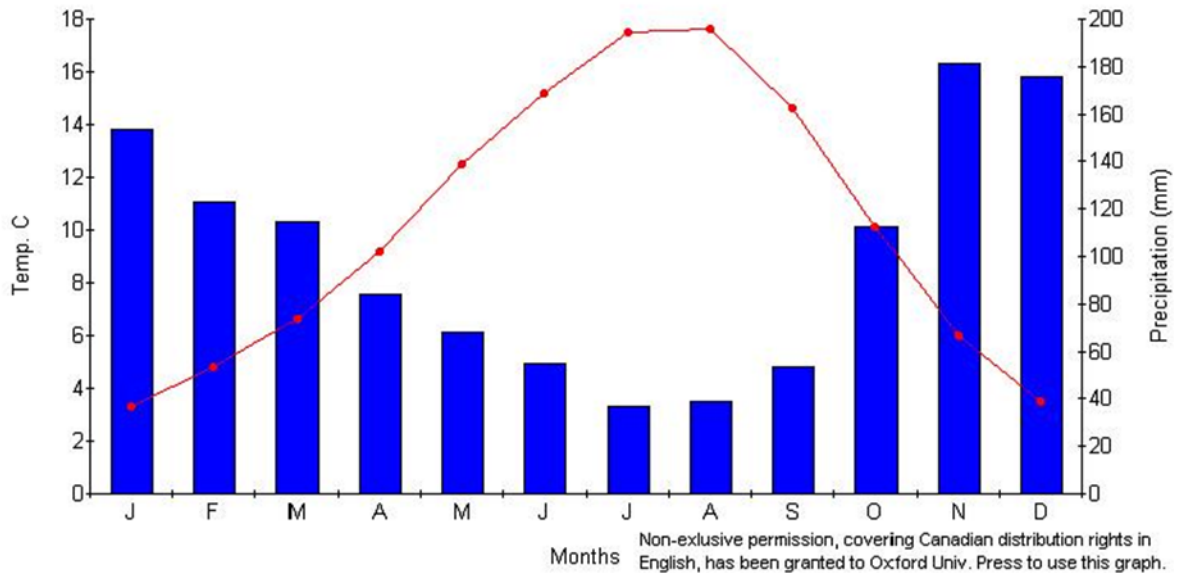

Figure 2: Daily Internet use, 2006 to 2013

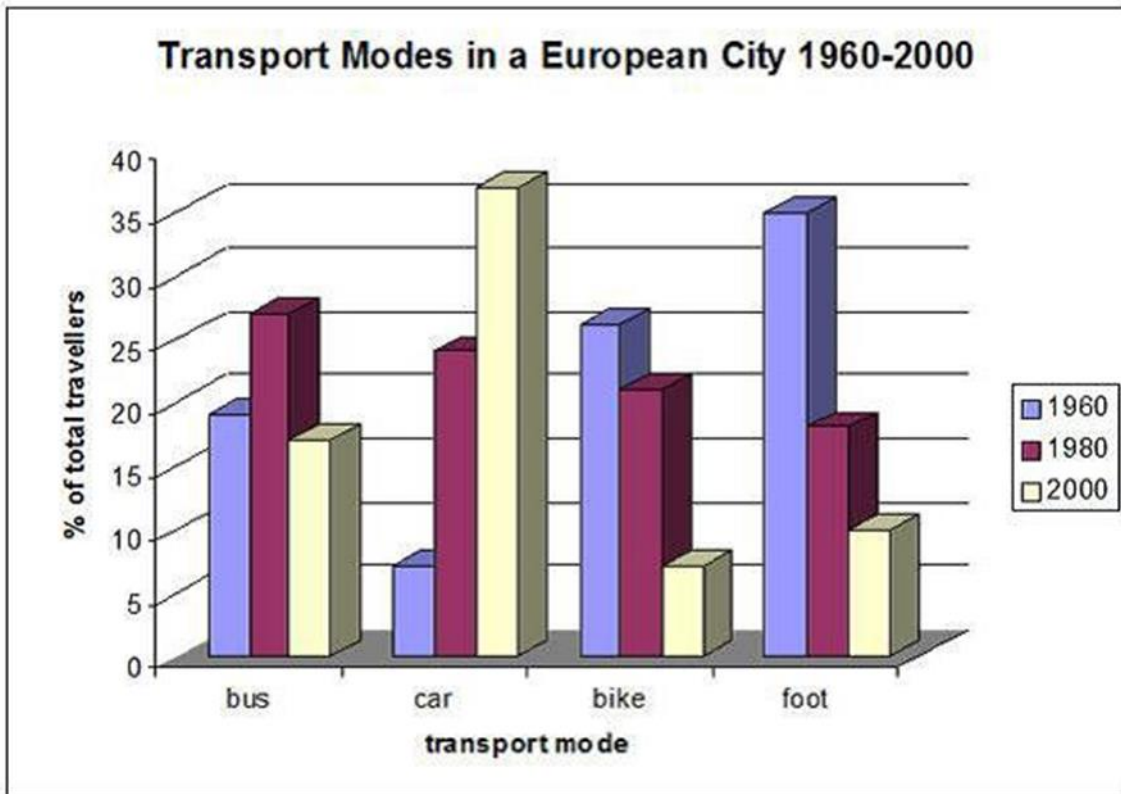

Figure 7. Earnings in Utopia, by sex

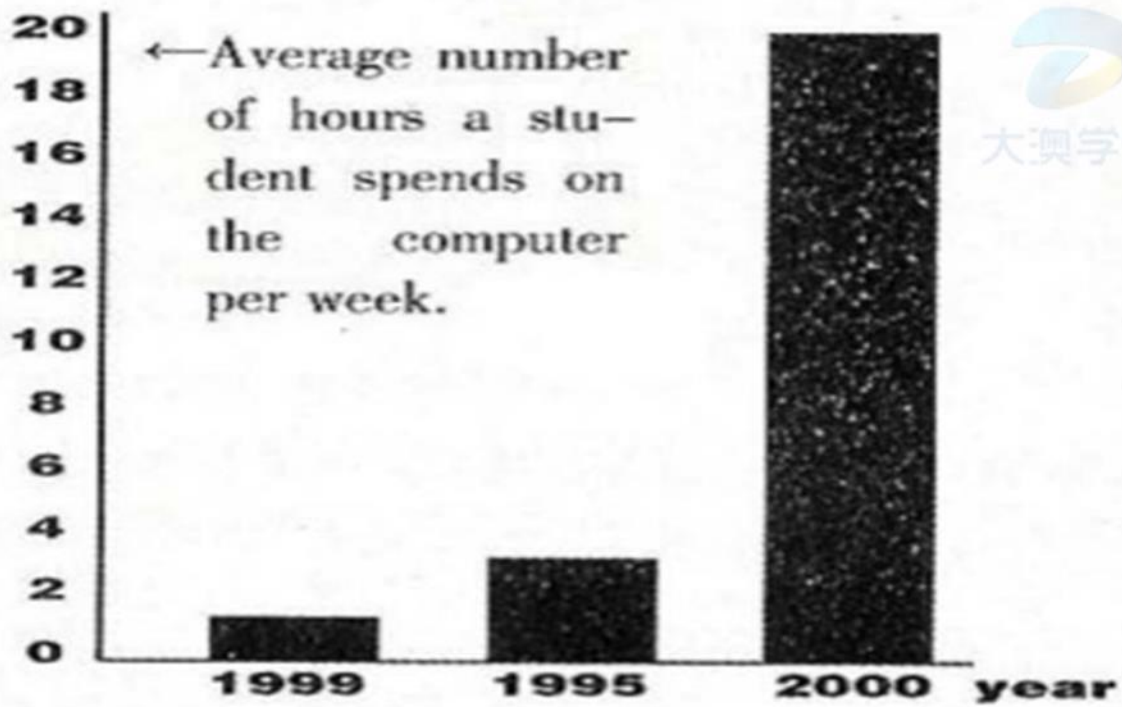

Proportion of overseas-born people in Australia, 2000–2010, by country of birth

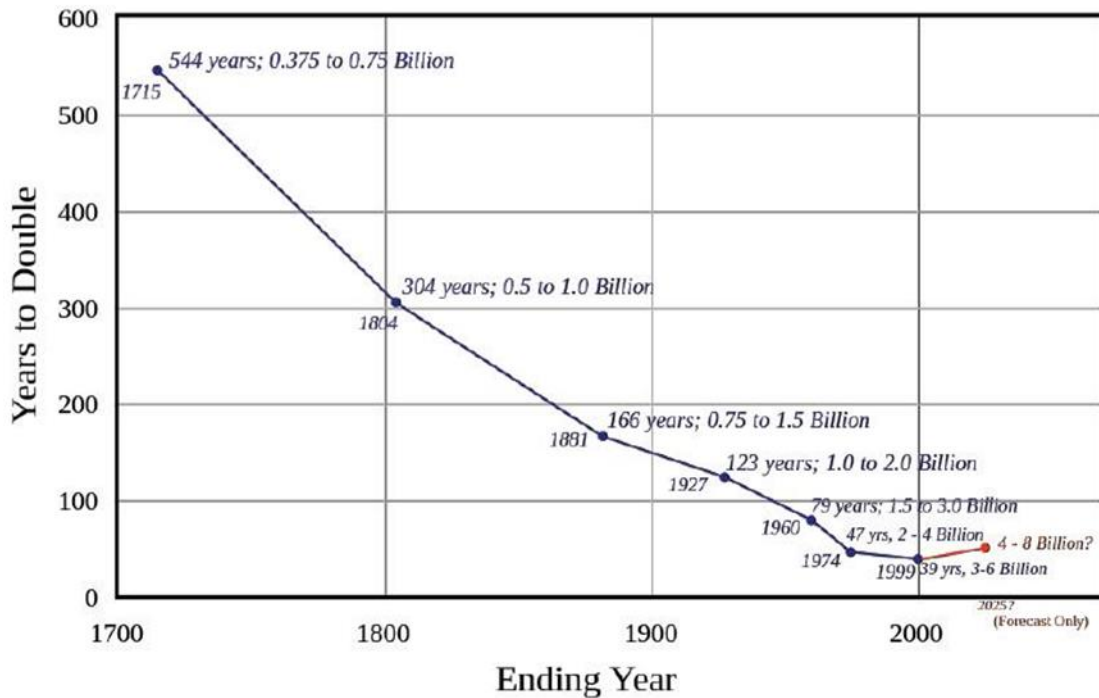

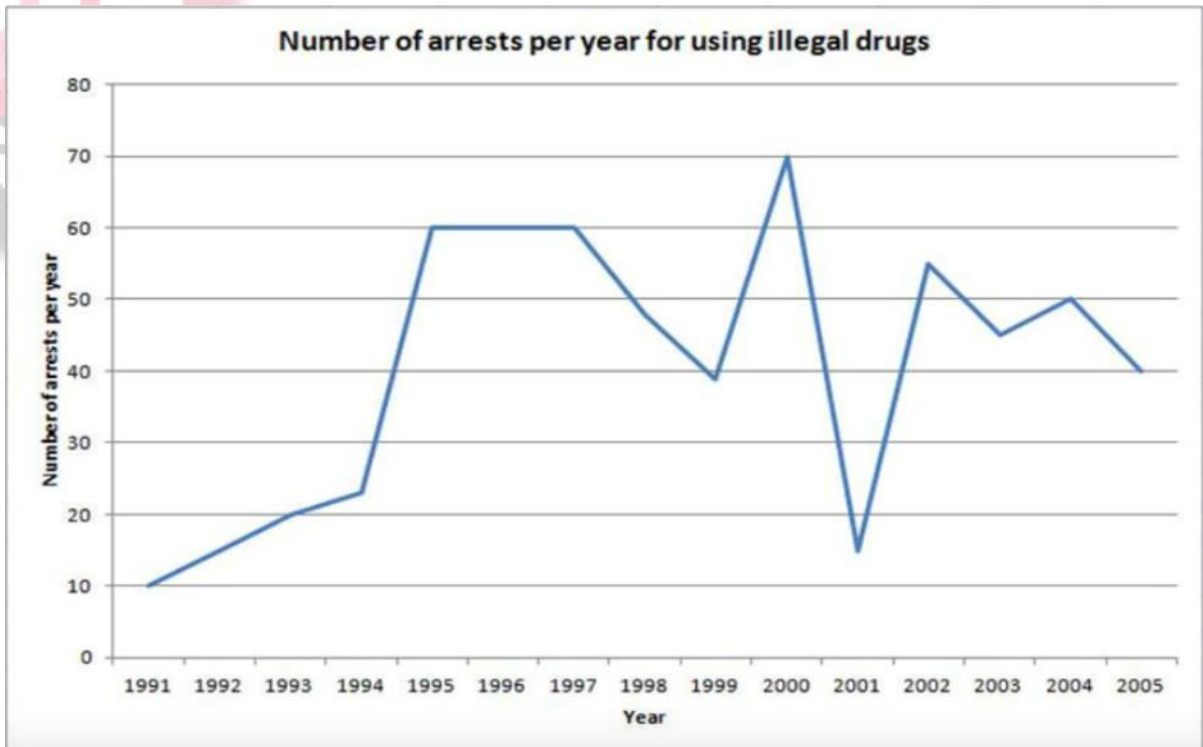
Graph : The graph gives information about Dubai Gold Sales in 2002

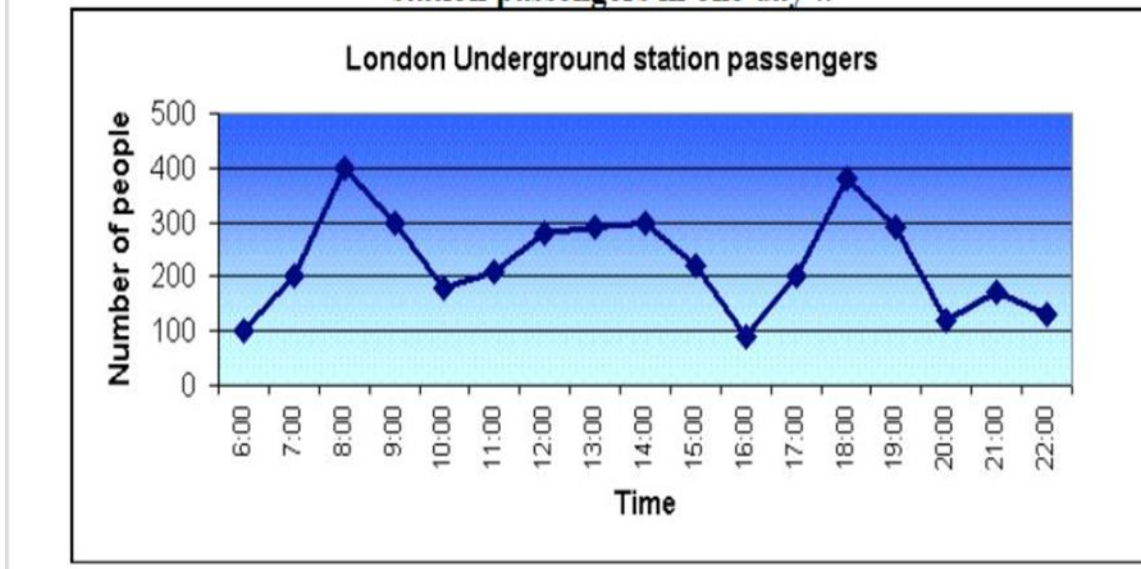


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Graph : The graph shows changes in the number of London Underground station passengers in one day ::

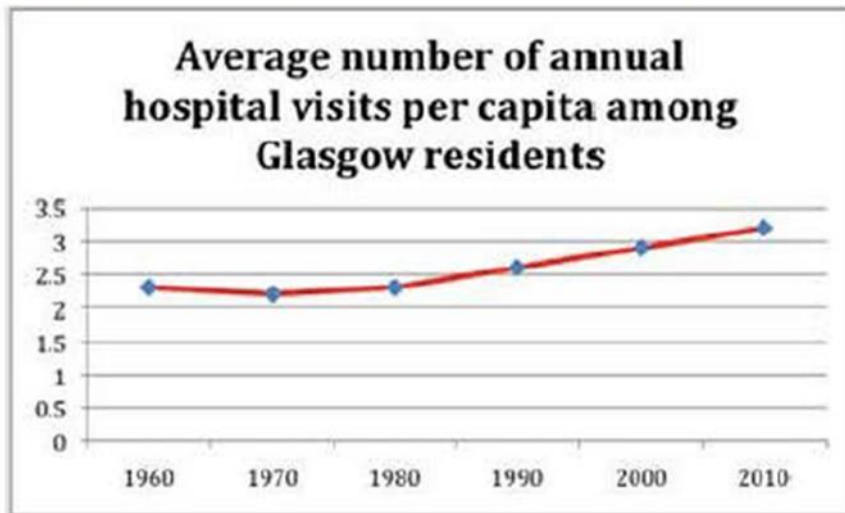

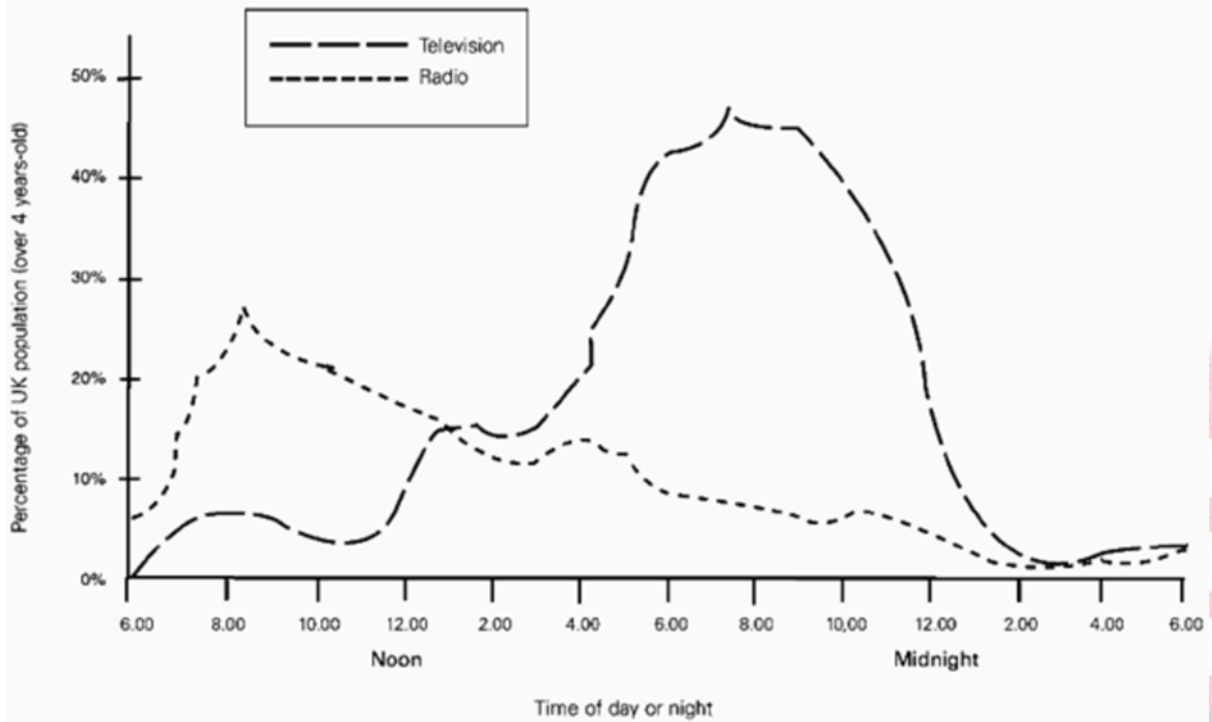

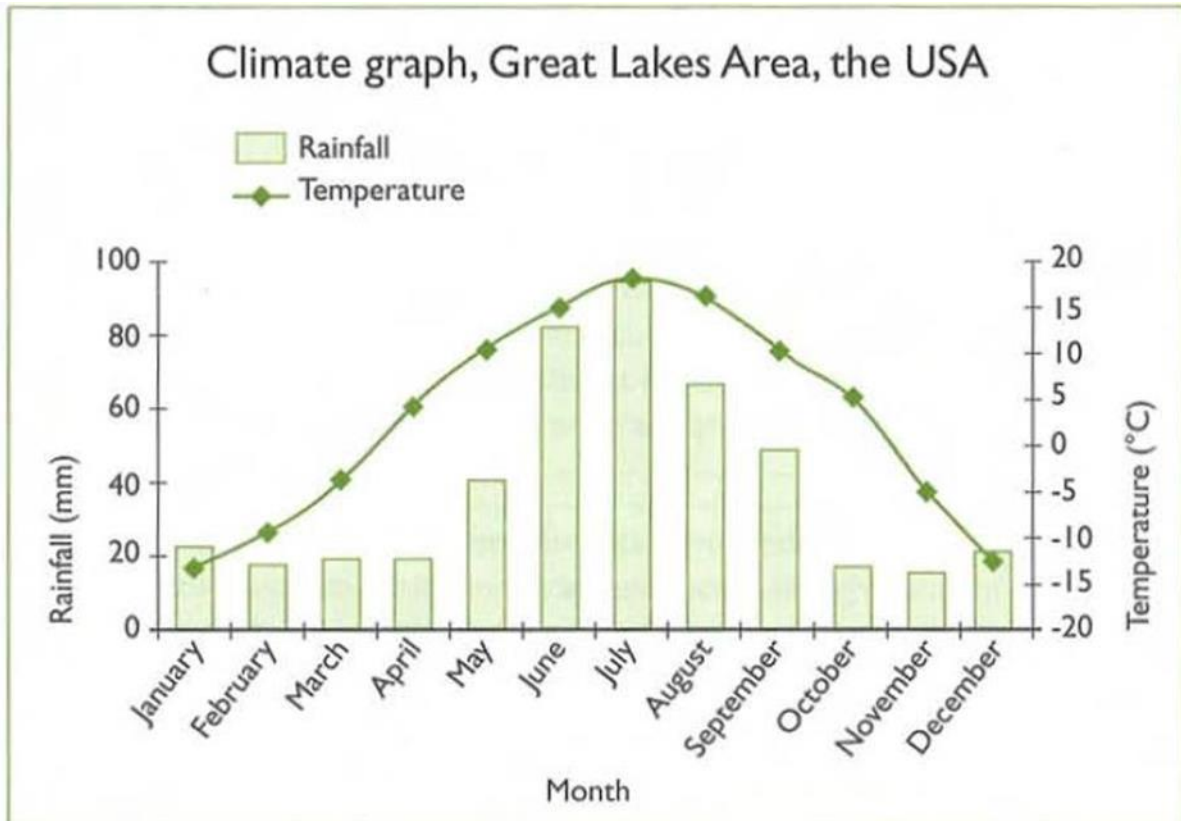
Figure 1 Many men are outside the labour force

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Figure 1: Life expectancy (years) at birth by sex, 1881–1890 to 2011–2013

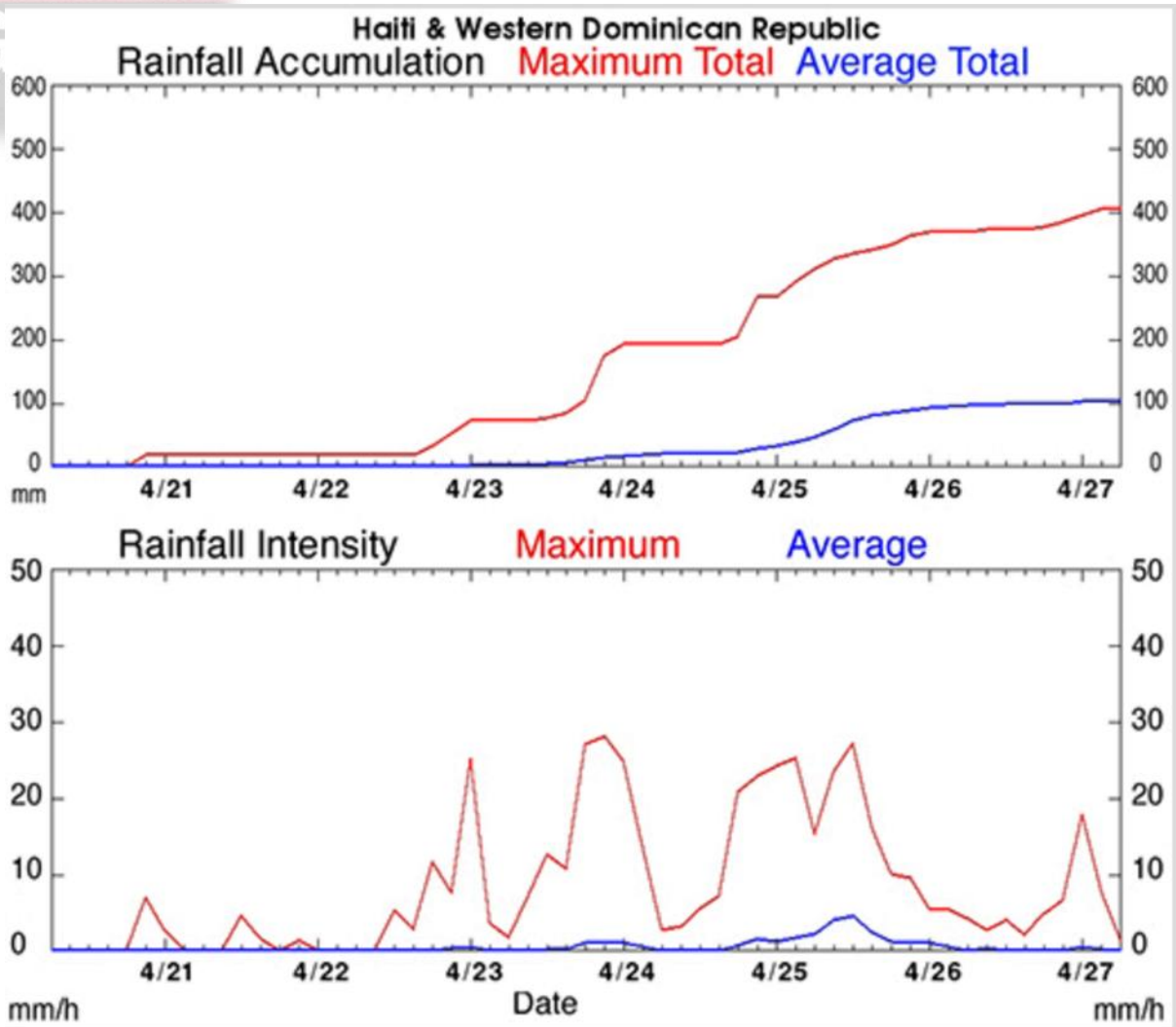

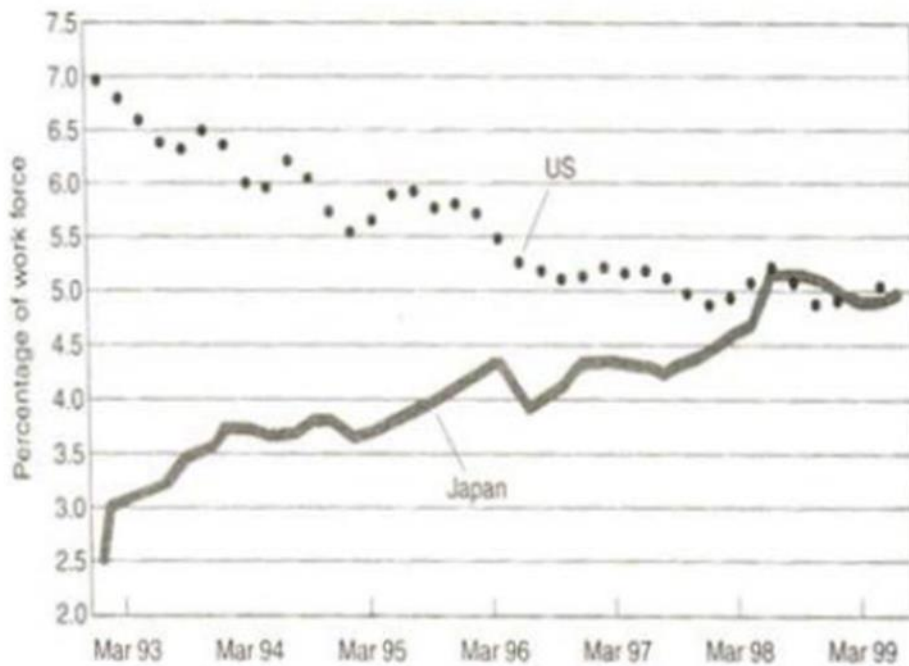
Electricity Generation in China by Type, 1994-2004

Graph : The graph shows the level of sports player's salaries from 1970 to 2000

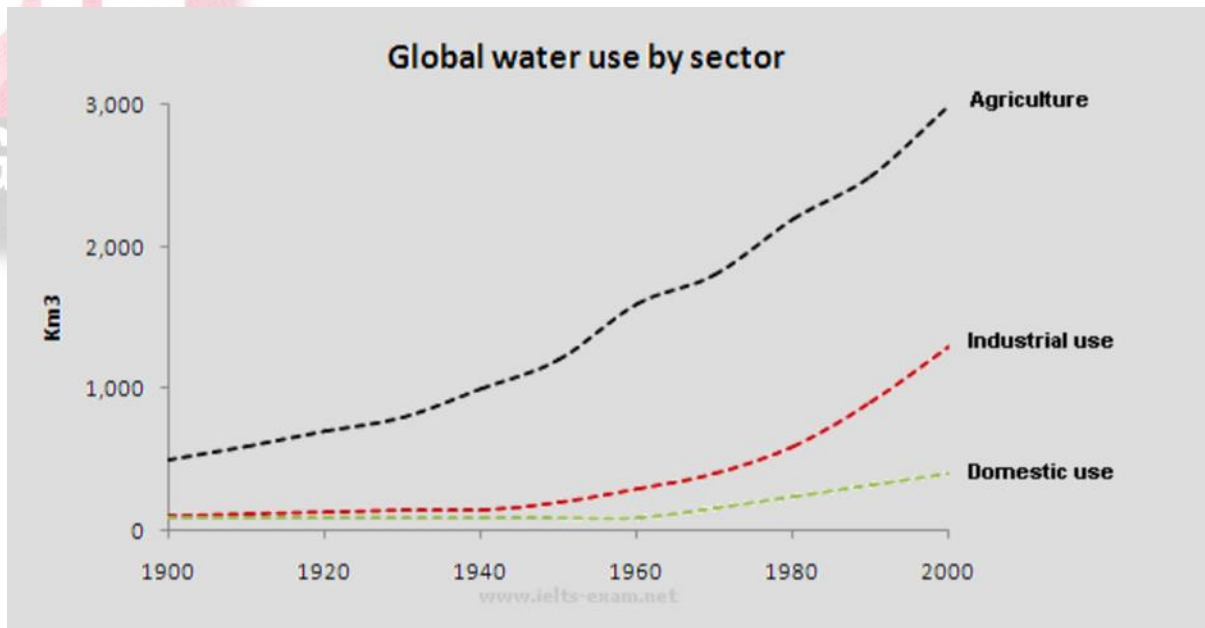

The proportion of energy produced from coal in four European countries from 1995 to 2010.

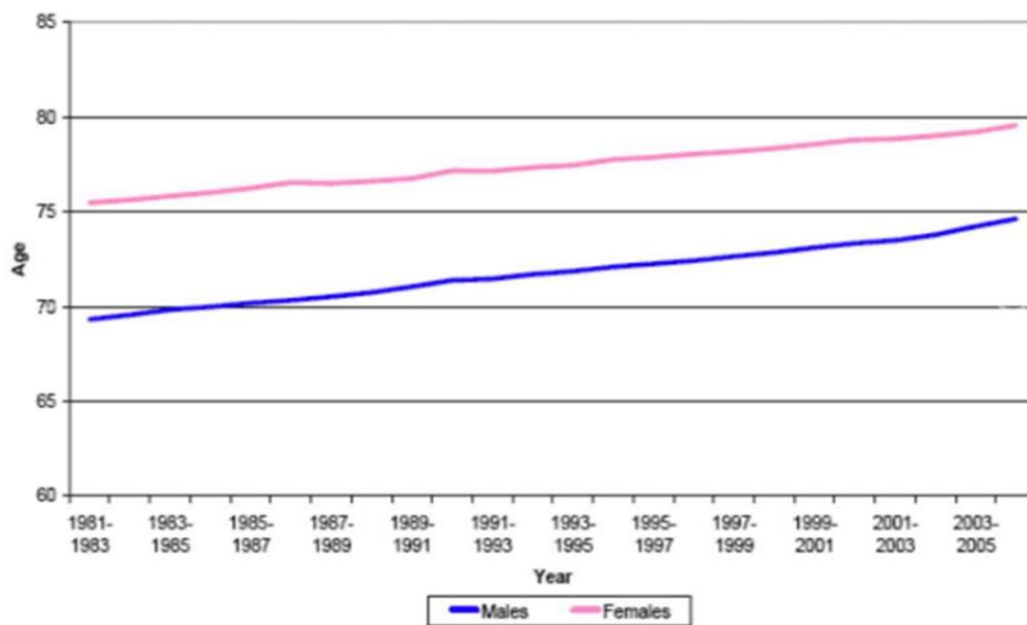

Figure 1. Injury Location



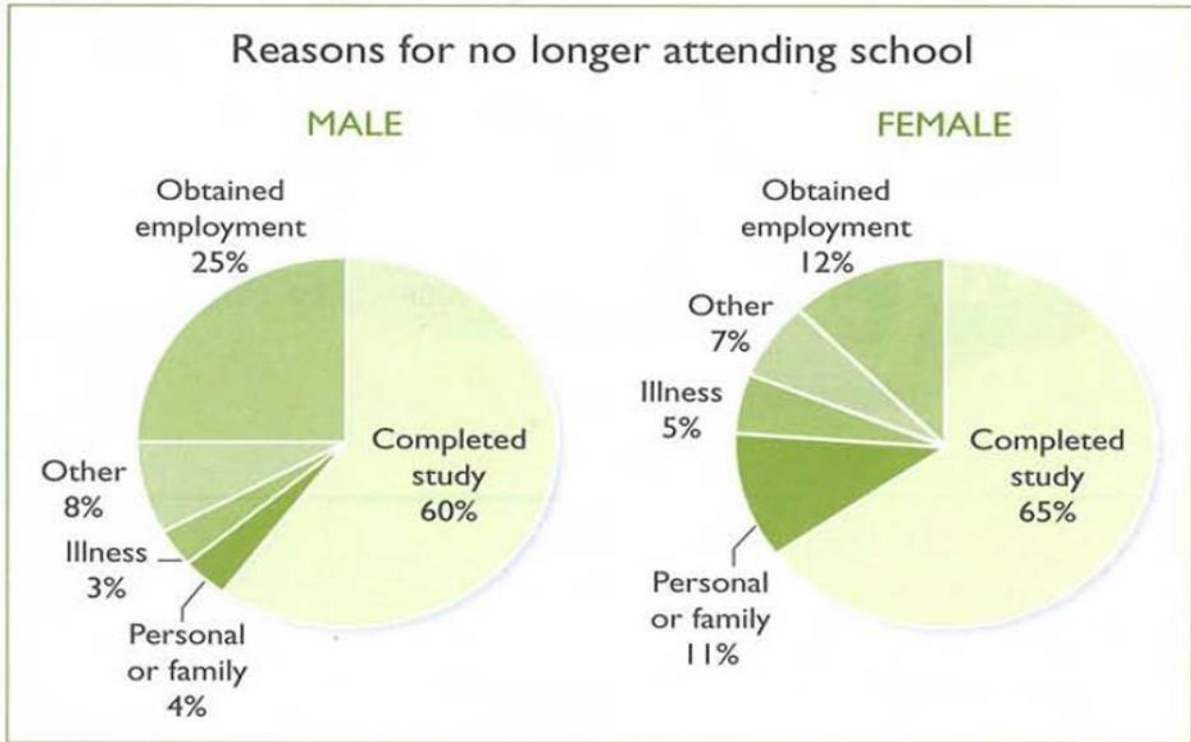

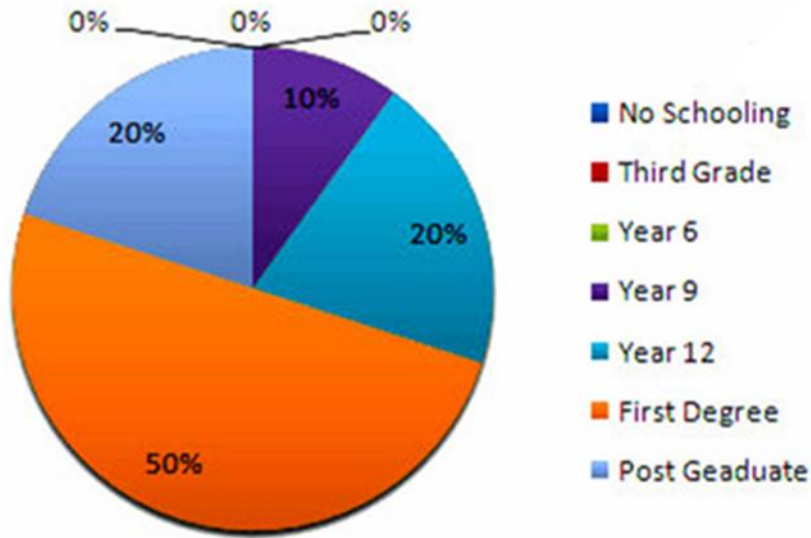
Share of deforested land ultimately converted for extensive agriculture³



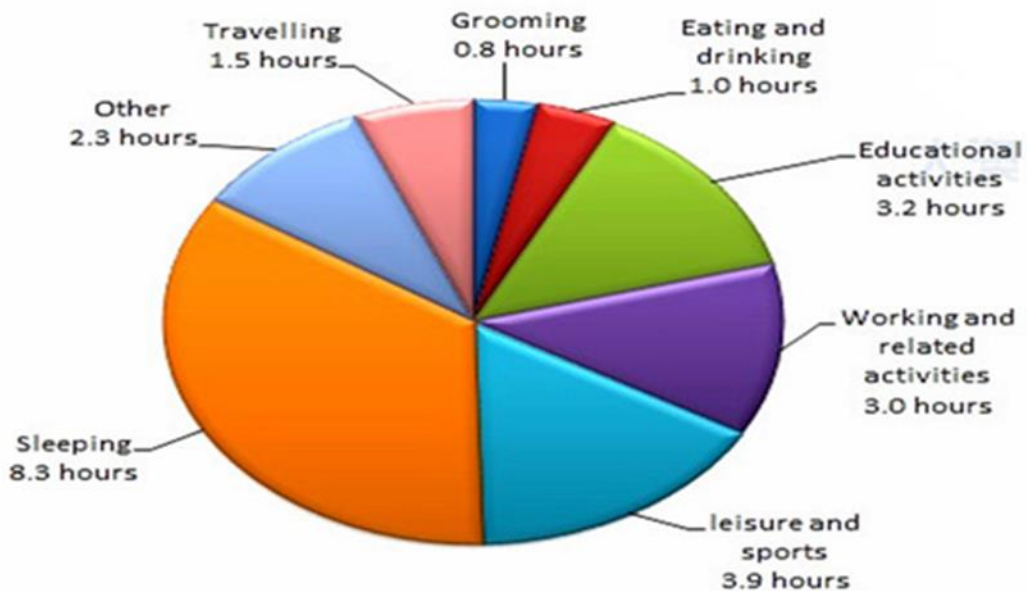

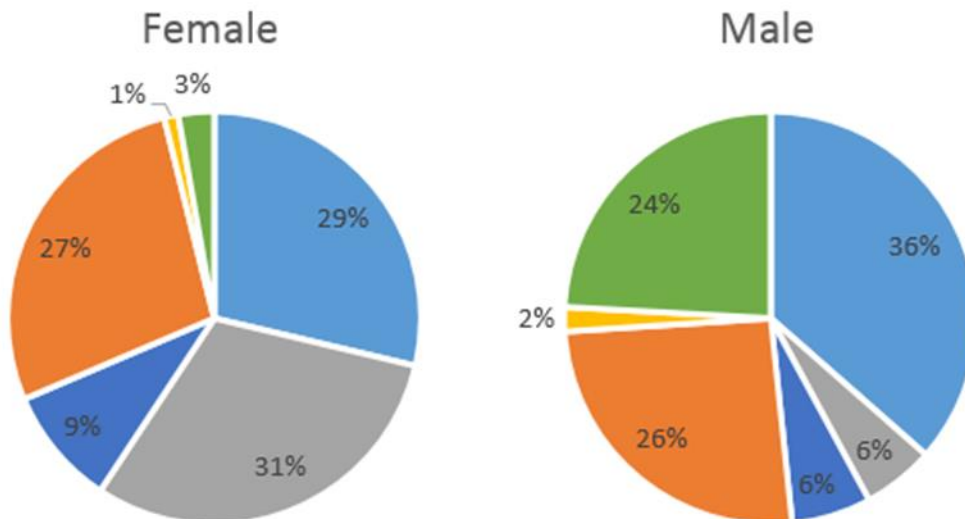
Percentage of Average Family Expenses in 1997

Map of Brandfield with two proposed sites for a shopping mall

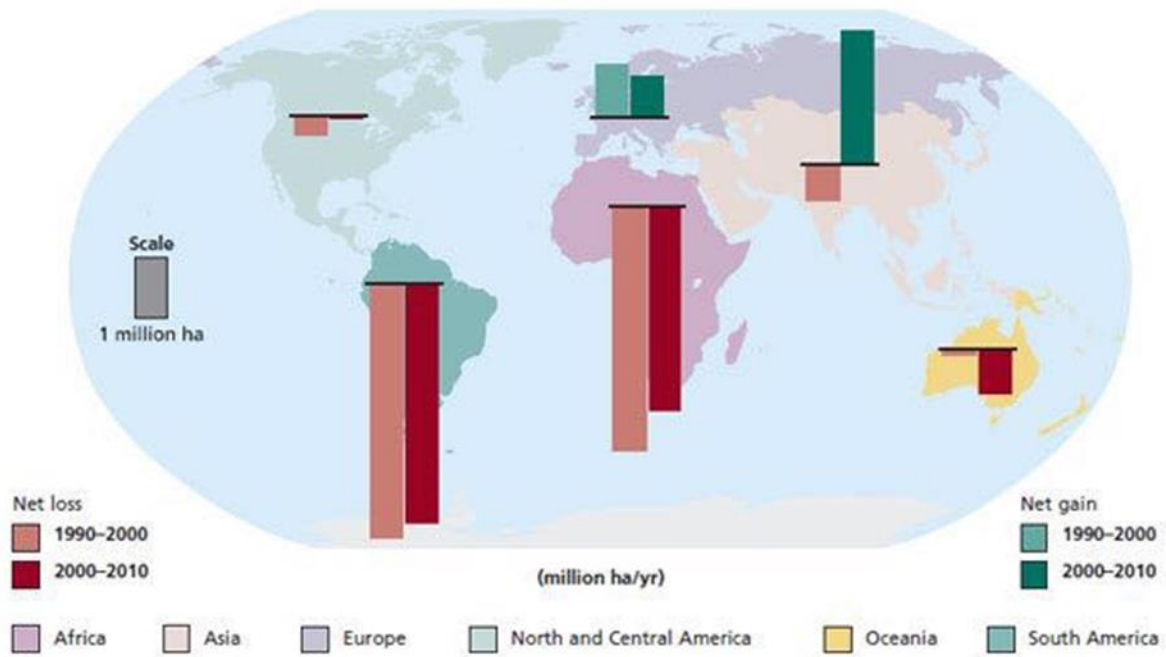

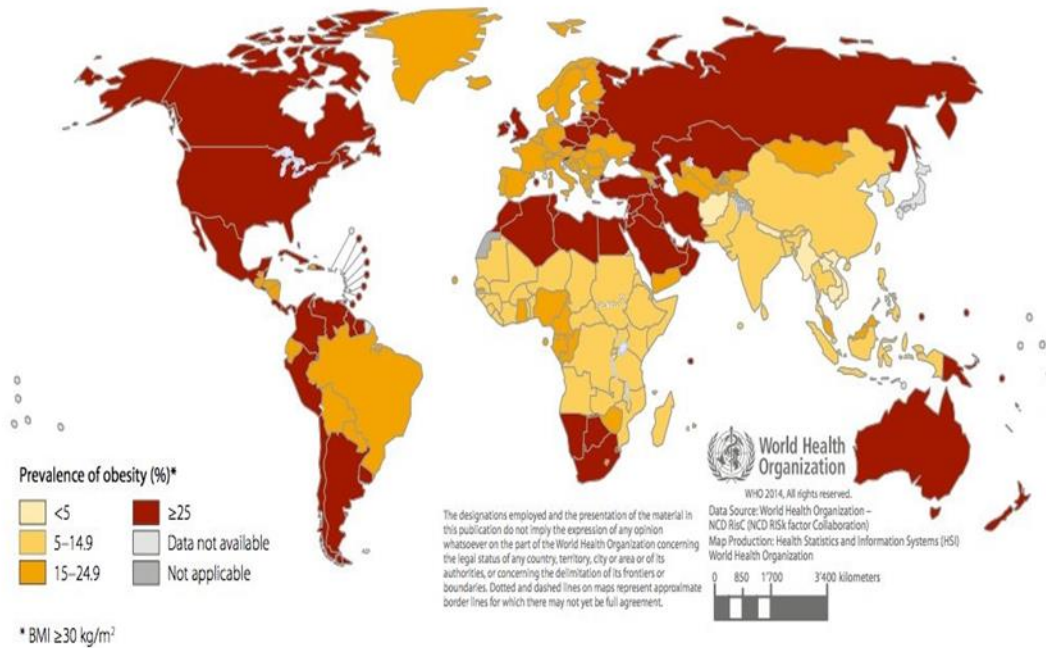

Fig. 7.2 Age-standardized prevalence of obesity in women aged 18 years and over (BMI ≥ 30 kg/m²), 2014



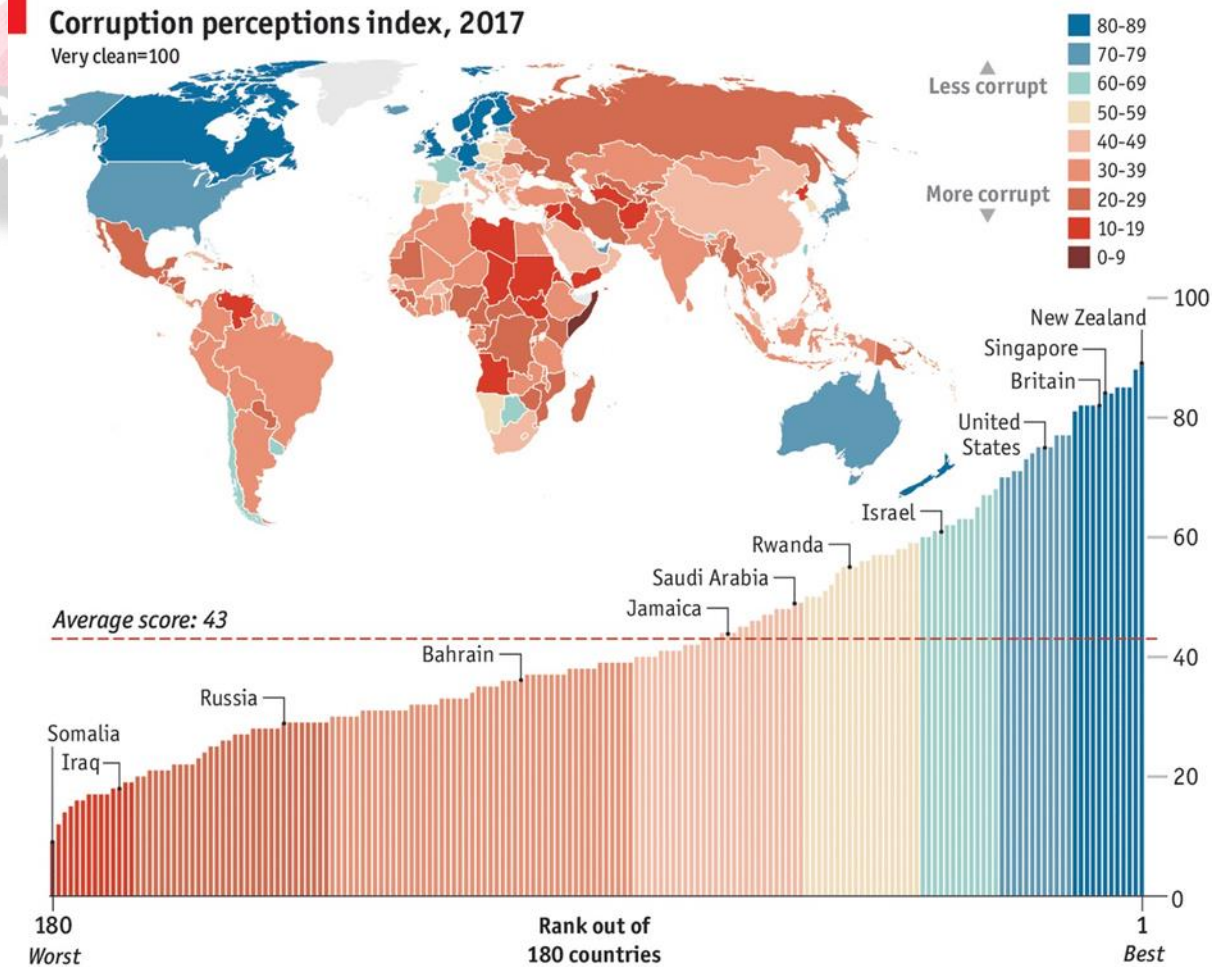
