Synecdoche	A figure of speech in which a part is made to represent the whole or vice versa. e.g. “The Western wave was all a-flame.” The “Western wave” is a synecdoche as it refers to the sea by the name of one of its parts i.e. wave.	
Paradox	A figure of speech in which a statement appears to contradict itself. e.g. To bring peace we must war. Be cruel to be kind.	
Onomatopoeia	A figure of speech wherein the word imitates the sound associated with the object it refers to. e.g. Pitter patter, pitter patter Raindrops on my pane.	
Rhetorical Questions	A figure of speech in the form of a question that is asked to make a point rather than to elicit an answer e.g. And what is so rare as a day in June?	

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
