John entered the non-profit sector after serving as President and CEO for Trim Systems LLC a \$400 million mobile equipment components company he founded and consolidated [Now Commercial Vehicles Group, Inc (CVGI-NASDAQ]. John began his career in government service, holding positions at the Federal level in the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, the Treasury Department and at the State level serving as the Chief Economic Advisor to the Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. In 1976 he was appointed by President Ford and confirmed by the U.S. Senate as Assistant Secretary for Employment Standards in the Labor Department.

Following public service, John spent 13 years with Cummins Engine Company in a series of manufacturing plant management positions, culminating as vice president for the worldwide engineering and manufacture of the company's midrange family of engines. At the Donaldson Company, a global manufacturer of engine and industrial filtration products he served as an executive vice president for engine filtration products world-wide before establishing Heavy Duty Holdings.

John graduated from Kent School and holds a BA and MBA from Harvard University, and Honorary Doctorate degrees from Centenary College and Shenandoah University. He currently serves as an adjunct professor at the College of Charleston's graduate school for public administration and on education advisory boards for Clemson University and the University of Florida.
