STORAGE AND PREPARATION

- It's essential to use a certified or experienced installer for the job.
- Clean dust from the tiles before installation.
- Store tiles in their original packaging, away from sunlight, moisture, water, and extreme temperatures.
- We recommend purchasing an additional 15% to 20% of material to account for any damage during transit and for future repairs.
- Mix tiles from several boxes to ensure a varied and natural appearance.
- Leave a 1-inch space on the subfloor for floors and walls to guarantee a level application.

TERRAZZO TILE INSTALLATION & MAINTENANCE GUIDE

ESSENTIALS FOR PROPER SETUP AND CARE

INSTALLATION

- If you have any doubts about your tiles, DO NOT proceed with installation.
- Tiles should be installed on a cured, flat, level, and stable concrete surface, or a compatible subfloor like Hardibacker, Durock, or Ditra. Installation on drywall-covered walls is also acceptable.
- Use a high-quality cementitious adhesive, such as Laticrete 253 (white) or Mapei Ultraflex LFT, for proper placement.
- Apply adhesive with a ½-inch notched trowel.
- Moist the back of the tile with a sponge before placing.
- Employ 1/16-inch spacers between tiles.
- Press tiles firmly in place for optimal adhesion and let dry for 24 hours.
- Clean the surface with a pH-neutral cleaner before sealing. We recommend Miracle Sealants pH Neutral or Stone Cleaner.
- Apply a terrazzo-appropriate sealer, like Miracle 511 Porous Plus, following the manufacturer's guidelines.
- Fill all joints with grout, remove excess promptly, and allow to dry for 24 hours. Mapei Flexcolor CQ grout is recommended.
- After grouting, clean the surface with a pH-neutral cleaner and apply a second sealer coat.

MAINTENANCE

- Regularly vacuum or sweep to remove abrasive substances.
- Use a pH-neutral cleaner for routine cleaning.
- Address spills, especially from grease, oil, or wine, immediately to avoid staining.
- For everyday maintenance, Miracle Sealants pH Neutral and Stone Cleaner is recommended. For tougher stains, use Miracle Sealants Heavy Duty Cleaner.
- Depending on traffic and wear, reseal every two years with Miracle 511 Porous Plus as needed.
