Eligibility:

Eligibility Requirements for NCAA Postseason Consideration: To be eligible to be considered for NCAA postseason assignment, officials must complete the following criteria:

- Register on RQ+ (refquest.com)
- Consent to a background check
- Pass Rules Test
 - o 50 questions
 - o 90% score required to pass
 - o Three (3) attempts allowed
- Attend the virtual referee seminar on August 24
 - o Additional details will be made available shortly
- Referee a minimum of 12 NCAA contests (men's season) 15 NCAA contests (women's season)
- Be nominated by at least one of the conferences with an AQ
- Whistle at a conference championship with an AQ
- Officiate no more than three (3) consecutive NCAA championships

NCAA water polo leadership and/or NCAA staff may add additional eligibility items.

Important Dates:

- Rules Test Available August 20, 2024 (Approximate Date)
- Referee Seminar August 24, 2024

The test will re-open in January for any officials only available to whistle the spring season.

General and Professional Liability Insurance:

As a part of your RQ registration, insurance is included for all intercollegiate contests. The program provides insurance for contests officiated from August 1, 2024 to August 1, 2025.

- \$6,000,000 per incident (\$1,000,000 General Liability and \$5,000,000 Excess)
 - o Includes personal and advertising injury, bodily injury and property damage, damage to premises, abuse, and molestation (domestic and international)
- \$1,000,000 per occurrence for Professional Liability coverage
 - o Includes errors and omissions, coordinators/supervisors, game graders, evaluators (domestic and international)



- \$15,000 Accident/Medical per occurrence
 - o Includes accidental death and dismemberment, excess accident/medical beyond existing coverage
- Option to expand coverage GL/PL coverage for all non-intercollegiate events
 - o Ability to extend coverage for officiating high school and other sanctioned contests
- Option to purchase increased game fee replacement insurance
 - This insurance offering is intended to cover instances where an injury or other medical event sustained from a covered accident renders you totally disabled and unable to work games you had been assigned. The coverage can pay fees for missed intercollegiate games, up to \$500 a week (for as many as 52 weeks).

Welcome Packet:

Hard copies of this year's rules book will begin shipping in September. Again this year, to reduce the cost of registration, an official may "opt out" of receiving a hard copy of the rules book. A digital version of the rules book will be available under "Publications" on Advantage.
