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RESOLUTIONS OF 31ST GOVERNING COUNCIL MEETING

Meeting Date	:	20th January, 2024 (Saturday)
Time	:	11.00 am
Venue	:	Board room

The meeting began with a welcome note by Principal and the resolutions of the meeting are,

- Principal informed the Hon. members of GC that, he assumed charge as Principal of SCEM on 31.10.2023 and welcomed all the GC Members to the 31st GC meeting.



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Resolutions

Resolutions		
Sub. (1)	:	To Confirm the proceedings of the 30 th Governing Council Meeting held on 19 th March 2022
Res.	:	The Principal presented the minutes of the 30 th GC meeting held on 19.03.2022. The committee resolved to confirm and approve the minutes. However, it was suggested that, the proceedings along with the action taken report be presented and a copy sent to GC members with the meeting invitation.
Sub. (2)	:	Appraisal of important activities and accomplishments of college from March 2022 till date
Res.	:	The Principal highlighted the important activities and achievements of the college from March 2022 till date through a power point presentation. The committee congratulated all the members for the accomplishments made, in particular the NAAC "A" grade secured by the college. The committee opined optimism about college achieving an A++ grade and suggested to apply for the same. However, the Director (R&D) informed that, due to the transition from being a constituent college of VTU to attaining autonomous status in 2021, the college cannot apply for NAAC until 2026.
Sub. (3)	:	Seeking post-facto approval for the appointments of CEO and Principal by Chairman, Bhandary Foundation
Res.	:	The Principal informed about the appointments of Mr. Johnson Telli as CEO and Dr. S. S. Injaganeri as Principal of Sahyadri College of Engineering and management and the same was unanimously approved by the committee.
Sub. (4)	:	Seeking post-facto approval for the appointments and resignations of teaching and non-teaching posts during the academic years 2022-23 and 2023-24
Res.	:	The Principal furnished the details of all the teaching and non-teaching staff appointed and also those who had resigned during the academic year 2022-23 and 2023-24. The Principal explained the regulations governing appointments and also the notice period for those leaving the college. The committee members suggested that, a feedback may be collected from faculty while leaving the college. The Chairman assured that feedback will be sought from the faculty members while leaving the college and Mr. Raman Madhok expressed readiness to analyze the feedback received. Dr. B Sadashive Gowda advocated the proposal for inclusion of a VTU representative in the faculty selection committee and also on conducting GC meeting bi-annually.
Sub. (5)	:	Presentation of Academic report of BE & MBA programmes



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Res.	: The Principal presented the academic report of BE and MBA programs, while Prof. Rashmi Bhandary provided an overview of the placement activities and the statistics. It was observed that, there was a decline in the placements due to the market recession affecting mass recruitment. To address this, efforts such as alumni connections, outreach programs, and regular distribution of brochures to industries was mentioned. The committee praised the initiatives taken and suggested for sharing of placement brochures with all the GC members. The Chairman congratulated Dr. Nisha and Dr. Rithesh Pakkala on earning their Ph.D degrees and also acknowledged the faculty members for the successful completion of NPTEL courses. Dr. B. Sadashive Gowda proposed enrolling first-year students in Infosys during spring semester to enhance knowledge and improve placement prospects. The Chairman expressed a Concern on the reduction in KSCST project funds and Dr. B. Sadashive Gowda recommended starting of full-time Ph.D programs, suggesting that, research scholars could teach BE students by providing a nominal stipend. The committee members advised felicitating faculty members upon acquiring Ph.D degree and motivating the faculty who publish papers by providing letters of appreciation. The Director R&D informed that, the faculty promotions are given to faculty members upon immediately acquiring the requisite eligibility criterion for the post as per AICTE norms.
Sub. (6)	: Seeking post-facto approval for the Results of Autonomous and VTU batches during the AY 2022-23 and 2023-24.
Res.	: The Principal presented the results of both Autonomous and VTU batches emphasizing the need for analysis and expressing encouragement for the commendable outcomes made by the students. The Chairman underscored the institution's commitment to ethical values and attendance policies, proposing that one classroom session per week be dedicated to interactive discussions for better comprehension of concepts. He highlighted the ecosystem created for student interaction on the Sahyadri campus. The committee members recommended fostering communication skills among students, suggesting regular student-led sessions to enhance communication. The UGC nominee proposed introducing remedial classes for problem-oriented subjects to underperforming students and incorporating extra sessions into the timetable. The Principal mentioned the existence of counselling and mentorship programs and the provision for the summer semester to clear the backlogs and also provision for mini/major projects. The exceptional conducive environment provided and infrastructure facilities created for student interaction were appreciated. The college campus is accessible 24/7 for the students also, was made a mention of. The members suggested for implementation of a system where proficient students could teach academically slow learners, with nominal remuneration as



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		an incentive. The Chairman mentioned that, at Sahyadri a Peer-to-Peer learning system for students has already been implemented.
Sub. (7)	:	Seeking post-facto approval for the Academic statutes and regulations revised for UG and PG programs offered during the year 2023-24
Res.	:	The Principal presented the Academic statutes and regulations revised and the same was approved by the committee for Gracing policy effective from the academic year 2024-25. The VTU nominee conveyed that, the summer semester must align with VTU regulations. Additionally, he specified that for the 2021 scheme, the summer semester could take place at the end of the IV and VIII semesters and however for the 2022 scheme at the end of the second semester, and there would be no summer semester for the 2023 scheme.
Sub. (8)	:	Seeking post-facto approval for declaring 1 st and 3 rd Saturday of every month as holiday to College
Res.	:	The Principal sought post-facto approval for declaring 1 st and 3 rd Saturday of every month as holiday to College based on the VTU circular. The VTU nominee recommended adhering to the VTU circular regarding holidays. After deliberation, the Chairman advised scheduling all activities on Saturdays and holidays to prevent disruptions to academic activities.
Sub. (9)	:	Seeking post-facto approval for the International conference conducted at college by IEEE during Sept./Oct. 2023
Res.	:	The Principal presented the details of the International conference conducted at college by IEEE during Sept./Oct. 2023 and sought for its approval. The committee members congratulated the organizers of the IEEE conference and suggested to issue an appreciation letter for their efforts. The members accorded approval for the same.
Sub. (10)	:	Seeking post-facto approval for establishing of laboratories in the new departments
Res.	:	The details of the laboratories established in the new departments was presented by the Principal and the committee members accorded their approval for the same.
Sub. (11)	:	Seeking approval for up-gradation of laboratories and internet band width
Res.	:	The HoDs of various department had requested for upgradation of laboratories in their respective departments and also for enhancing the internet band width in some of the class rooms and common areas. The Principal presented the details and also the estimated budget required for the same. The committee members upon discussion approved the same in total.
Sub. (12)	:	Seeking approval for making the HoDs post on rotational basis



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Res.	:	A detailed deliberation was carried out on making HoDs post on rotational basis. The committee proposed that, the rotation of department heads could be determined on an individual basis rather than having an established fixed policy as the college has become autonomous only in 2021.
Sub. (13)	:	Seeking post-facto approval of the Audit reports for the Financial Year 2021-22 & 2022-23
Res.	:	The audit reports for the Financial Year 2021-22 and 2022-23 was presented by the Principal to the Committee members and it was resolved to approve the same.
Sub. (14)	:	Seeking post-facto approval of the budget for the Financial Year 2023-24 and also approval of the proposed budget for the FY 2024-25
Res.	:	A discussion was held with regards to the proposed budget. It was suggested to present a comparison of the budget for the previous year and the current year, highlighting the percentage increase in the budget required. Further, there was a suggestion to categorize the budget into capital and operational expenses. The committee members approved the proposed budget for the Financial Year 2023-24 and 2024-25.
Sub. (15)	:	Seeking approval for establishing Extension Research Centre at Bangalore
	:	The Chairman provided information on the proposed plan to set up an extension research Centre at Bangalore with an objective of fostering connection with other Higher learning institutions and the industries. The aim is to build a strong network for engaging students and faculty members in to research, consultancy and online real-time project mentoring. The committee was exited to hear about this new initiative and accorded approval for the same.
Sub. (16)	:	Seeking post-facto approval for establishing ATAL Community Innovation Centre (ACIC) at College for enriching the activities of AIM
Res.	:	The CEO informed the members that, the Niti Ayog has approved the college proposal for establishing ATAL Community Innovation Centre and has sanctioned a grant of Rs. 2.50 crores. However, an equal matching grant is to be contributed by the institute aligning with its commitment to product development and fostering in-house start-ups. The CEO highlighted that Niti Ayog has extended an offer to elevate the innovation centre to an incubation centre over the next three years, with a specific focus on establishing a Fintech incubation Centre in the Mangalore region. Further, in alignment with this initiative, the Karnataka Acceleration Network, GoK has granted Rs. 2.50 crores for start-up promotion. This endeavour aims to showcase a national identity by promoting start-ups, with an emphasis on attracting 40 start-ups from beyond



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		the Bangalore region. Also, the centre seeks to create an ecosystem that facilitates internships for individuals outside the Sahyadri student's community.
Sub. (17)	:	Seeking post-facto approval for the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Constituted for the period 2022-23 to 2024-25
Res.	:	The committee reconstituted with the newly nominated members was presented to the Committee and the same was approved.
Sub. (18)	:	Seeking approval for internal stock verification for AY 2023-24
Res.	:	The Principal briefed about the regular internal stock verification to be carried out at the end of an academic year and the same was approved by the committee. In addition to the stock verification, the committee appraised of the external academic & administrative audit to be carried out, comprising professionals from higher learning institutions and representatives from industry also.
Sub. (19)	:	Seeking permission to issue appropriate documents for receiving grants from different agencies like SERB, DST etc. in consultation with the Chairman
Res.	:	The need for issuing the documents for receiving grants from different agencies like SERB, DST etc. in consultation with the Chairman Committee was apprised to the members and the same was accorded the approved.
Sub. (20)	:	Ratification of the constitution of Academic Council and BoS for functioning of Autonomous process as per the UGC/VTU norms
Res.	:	The Academic Council and the BoS constituted in departments were presented to the Committee members by Principal. The committee suggested to incorporation more industry representatives into the Board of Studies (BoS) of all the departments. It approved the list of committee members for both Academic Council and also the BoS of all the departments.
Sub. (21)	:	Seeking approval for submission of application on to AICTE web portal for Extension of Approval (EoA) and applying for the increase/reduction in intake and starting or closure of UG/PG programmes, Change in Course name for the Academic Year 2024-25
Res.	:	The Principal presented the report of the admission statistics and deliberated on the potential renaming of the BE Programme in Mechanical Engineering. In response, the Chairman sought suggestions from the committee members and proposed for inclusion of subjects with a flavour of Computer Science and AI within the Mechanical Engineering



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		Programme. Further, it was resolved to have the same intake as in previous academic year owing to shortage of faculty to teach IT related subjects.
Sub. (22)	:	Seeking approval to take action with regards to financial and legal matters in consultation with the Chairman, GC, SCEM
Res.	:	The necessity for taking action with regards to financial and legal matters in consultation with the Chairman, GC, SCEM was informed to the committee members and the same was accorded approval.
Sub. (23)	:	Seeking Post-facto approval to incorporate EPF to both teaching and non-teaching staff and other incentives to teaching faculty
Res.	:	The Employee Provident Fund scheme (EPF) incorporated to both teaching and non-teaching staff and other incentives to be provided to the teaching faculty was highlighted to the committee members and the same was approved.
Sub. (24)	:	Seeking Post-facto approval to donate Nano-technology equipment and accessories to VTU Belgaum
Res.	:	It was deliberated that funds were allocated for nano-technology equipment several years ago, yet the utilization was hindered by the impact of COVID. Consequently, approval was sought to donate the equipment to VTU, Mudhenahalli. Additionally, the Director of Research and Development provided insights into the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) established with VTU. The committee acknowledged and granted approval for both initiatives.
Sub. (25)	:	Discussion on starting New University i.e. Private University/Deemed-to-be University/University of Excellence
Res.	:	The Principal presented the structure and modalities for starting a deemed to be university. The committee deliberated on the matter and suggested formulate and to put forth a roadmap outlining the institute's vision and mission for 2030, aiming to establish a pragmatic vision for its evolution into a university. The Chairman informed to gather additional information on the prospects of becoming a deemed or state university.
Sub. (26)	:	Any other matter with the permission of the Chair
Res.	:	Mrs. Deeksha Rai suggested to implement the suggestions given by all the committee members. She also emphasized on sending an action taken report on the proceedings of GC meetings to all the members.



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- Mrs. Umadevi S. Y. acknowledged and also commended the accomplishments made by the college. She also recalled and recognized Sahyadri College of Engineering & Management for its innovative initiatives. Additionally, she proposed conducting two GC meetings annually.
- A discussion on having corpus fund and also to have vision-craft exercise to the top management to make provision for the corpus fund.
- Members suggested to apply for QS I-GAUGE ranking.
- Mr. Subramanian M. V. acknowledged and extended congratulations for the institutional achievements. He recommended visiting premier institutions to gain insights into their research culture and teaching-learning processes. He also suggested to have a comparative analysis of proposed budget with the previous year. Furthermore, he suggested renaming the Mechanical Engineering course in alignment with space technology trends. He also recommended to initiate, blended mode of teaching (physical and digital combined), with input from industry and academic experts through the research extension center.
- Dr. B. Sadashive Gowda suggested student and faculty exchange programs through collaborations with Universities abroad to showcase the visibility of the Sahyadri institute at National and International level, also it will facilitate for higher studies. The Chairman informed that, the process of international collaboration is in progress.
- The committee suggested to include agenda points categorized according to priorities

The meeting concluded with vote of thanks from the Chairman and Principal to all the members present.

Back Ground:

As this equipment is not being utilized at the UG level Institute. The management of Bhandary Foundation decided to donate the same to Visvesvaraya Technological University to utilize in its PG Center of Nano Science & Technology to be used for the benefit of stakeholders of the University. Hence, the proposal was sent to University. The same was accepted by the University to agreement the Nano Science Laboratory at its PG Center at Muddenahalli Campus on the following mutually accepted terms and conditions.

- (i) The University will shift the equipments to Muddenahalli Campus and re-install in their Laboratory.
- (ii) The Laboratory so established to be named after **“Bhandary Foundation (R) Laboratory, Shivamogga”**.
- (iii) A top student who gets highest marks in M.Sc / M.Tech in the Nano Science & Technology may be awarded with a certificate and a medal in the name of **“Sahyadri College of Engineering & Management, Mangaluru”** in an annual convocation of the University every year by establishing an endowment in the name of Bhandary Foundation.
- (iv) The staff and students of Sahyadri College of Engineering & Management, Mangaluru may be permitted to make use of the laboratory for their academic research work without affecting the normal work of the University.



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Both the parties are agreed with faith and pleasure and signed the document on behalf of Bhandary Foundation and Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi by its officials.

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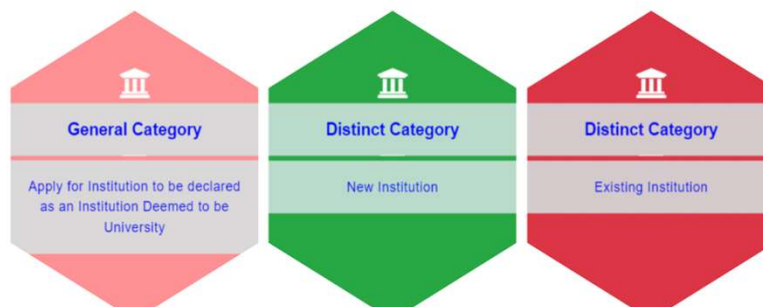

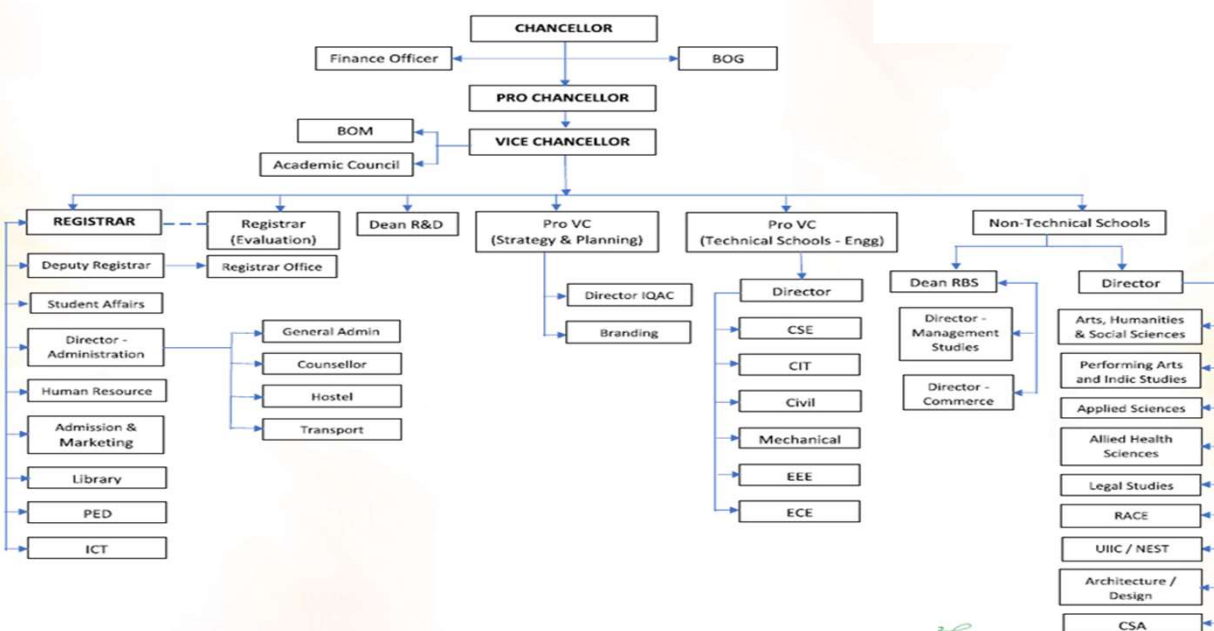
