Sub: TRANSFERS - Transfers and postings of employees of APPTD –

Relaxation of ban – Instructions to the Unit Officers– Reg.

Ref: 1) GO Ms No.75 of Finance (HR.I-PLG.&POLICY) Dept., dated 17.08.2024

2) Notification NO. PD- 19/2024 Dated: 19.08.2024

Comprehensive guidelines were issued through Notification at reference 2nd cited above, outlining the specific procedure to be followed for transfer of APPTD employees, in the light of the lifting of ban on transfers of Government employees, vide GO Ms No. 75 dated 17.08.2024.

At para (5) of the said notification, the following instructions were issued with respect to Cadre strength adjustments in the present transfer orders.

While considering request transfer applications, the following order of priority shall be followed.

1st priority: Employees who were shifted to other units either in same or other regions/zones during cadre strength adjustment, but are physically working at the current depots on relieving basis, **in the ascending order of their retirement date;** (those who are retiring early shall be given preference)

2nd priority: Employees who were reinstated on consideration of appeal/review/ mercy petitions or court orders and posted to other units due to non-availability of cadre strength in the parent Regions, in the ascending order of their retirement date; prioritising those closest to their retirement date, to the extent possible; and finally

3rd priority: Request transfer applications of employees from other depots, in the order of Regional Seniority.

In this regard, several representations are received expressing concern that the 1st priority and 2nd priority clauses which are determined by the ascending order of retirement date is causing considerable distress to many employees whose retirement dates are far in the future. When assigning priority based on the date of retirement, the seniority of the employees is being overlooked. As a result, the senior most employees are placed at a disadvantage.

In view of the above, it is requested to assign the said priority only to the employees who are retiring **upto 31.05.2025**. In respect of employees retiring beyond 31.05.2025, the order of Regional/Zonal seniority, as applicable, may be followed.

Upon through examination of the issue, the following guidelines are issued for strict implementation at the depots/units.

While considering request transfer applications of employees **against cadre strength adjustments**, in the 1st priority and 2nd priority, preference shall be given to the employees who are retiring upto **31.05.2025** only in the **ascending order of their retirement date**. In respect of employees retiring beyond 31.05.2025, the order of Regional/Zonal seniority, as applicable, shall be followed.

All ED:Zones and DPTOs are requested to implement the above guidelines and complete the transfer process smoothly, within the prescribed time limits.
