Summary Result ⇒ **POSITIVE.**

Comments:

- [Name] performed stress test in Bruce protocol for the evaluation of IHD (angina pectoris).
- Exercise capacity was good.
- Inotropic and chronotropic responses were normal.
- ECG at rest shows no abnormality.
- ECG during exercise & recovery shows significant ST- T Changes.
- Significant ST-T changes seen in >1.0 mm seen in leads- V3-V6 in stage-3 & stage-4 during exercise.

Conclusion :

- ❖ Stress test is **POSITIVE** for ECG evidence of provokable myocardial ischemia.
