

## WEBSTER COUNTY PHEASANTS FOREVER SCHOLARSHIP

**Purpose**: Two scholarships will be presented to two Webster County residents who are High School Seniors and who are pursuing programs in fields of study involving: Conservation, Natural Resources, Wildlife Biology or Animal Ecology.

**Amount**: Two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.00 each. Scholarships will be paid directly to the school of the recipient's choice, beginning with the first term of attendance.

**Basis of Award**: Criteria of consideration for the scholarship will be based on points. 45-points for need, 30-points for leadership, and 25-for scholastic achievement.

Leadership includes: service, self-motivation and character -- 10 points each.

Scholarship achievement is based on a C average or better.

**Selection**: All applications must be typed and sent to Webster County Pheasants Forever, c/o Scholarship Committee, 1518 Knollcrest Dr. Fort Dodge Ia. 50501 Applications must be postmarked no later than April 30th.

Applications must be accompanied with:

- 1. School attendance record
- 2. Your grade point average
- 3. Your current class ranking

Finalists for the scholarship may be required to present themselves for an interview with the Selection Committee.
