Logotype

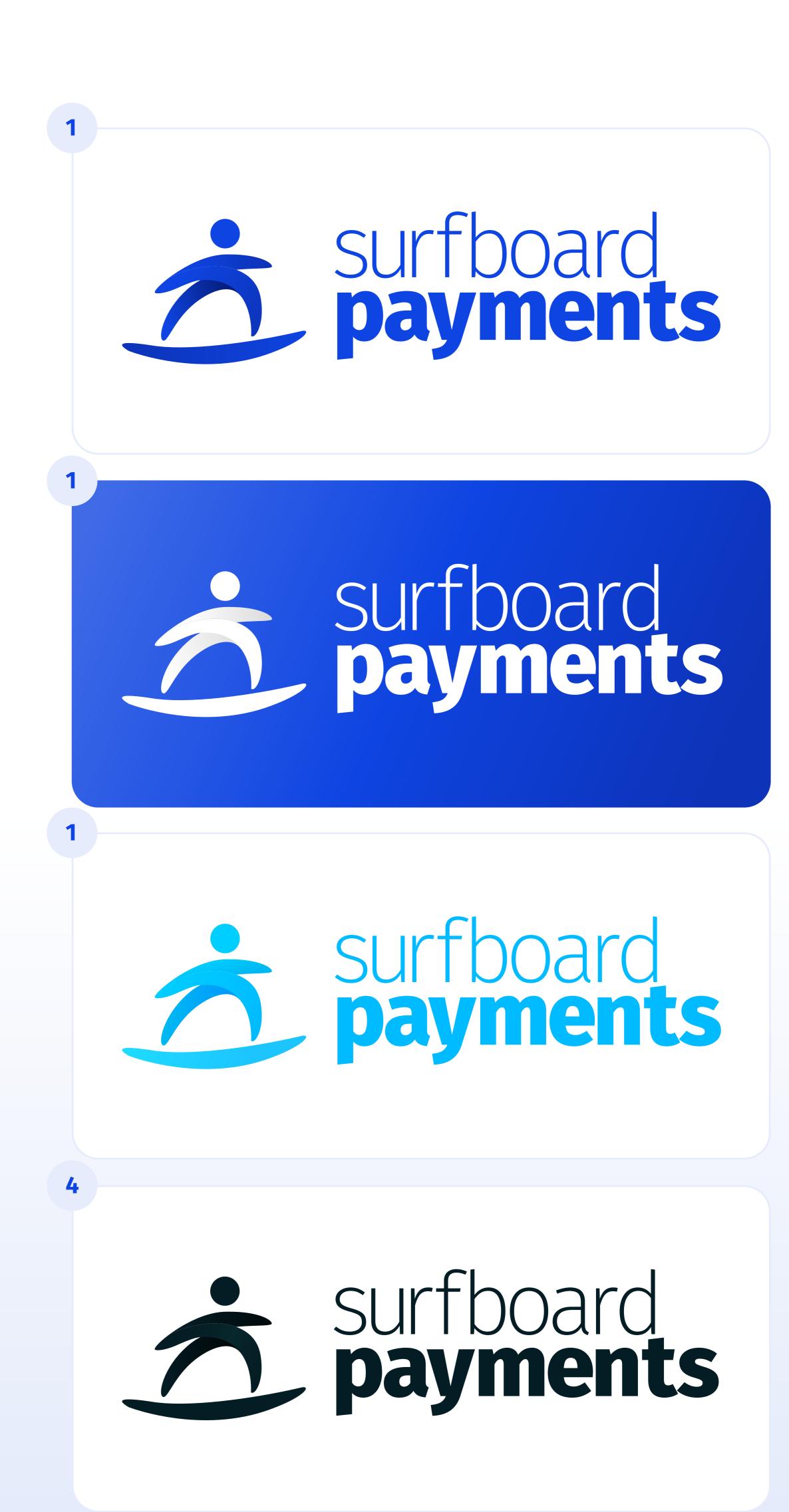
The Surfboard logotype contains two key elements. The first one is the logo-icon, the surfer on the surfboard which is representing two things:

- The atmosphere at the company
- The waves the client rides by the provided surfboard from us

Then there is the logo-text. The bolder **payments** is to give the viewer of the logotype a clear idea of what type of industry our waters are running through.

The primary logotype variant is the deep blue sea gradient (1) whether or not the logo is used in full or just the icon to ensure brand recognition. The previous lighter blue variant (3) is still in use and can be seen throughout any material produced by Surfboard Payments, but not as the primary one.

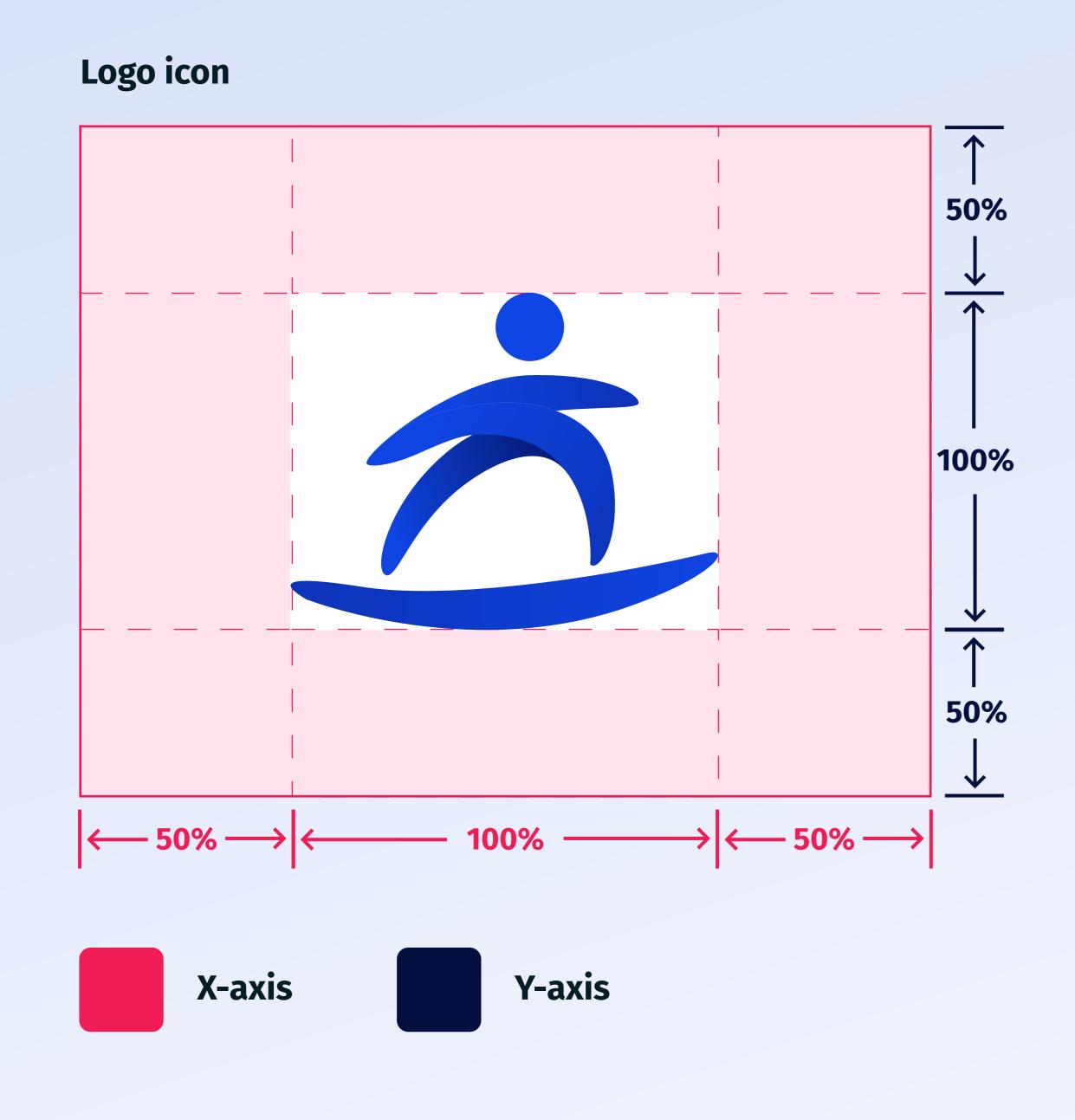
The white logotype contains gradient to reflect a shadow on the surfer (2) and is used whenever the background color uses our deep blue sea color. Together with these three variants we also have a fourth one, a very dark blue - almost black. This variant is used very rarely.





Logotype spacing

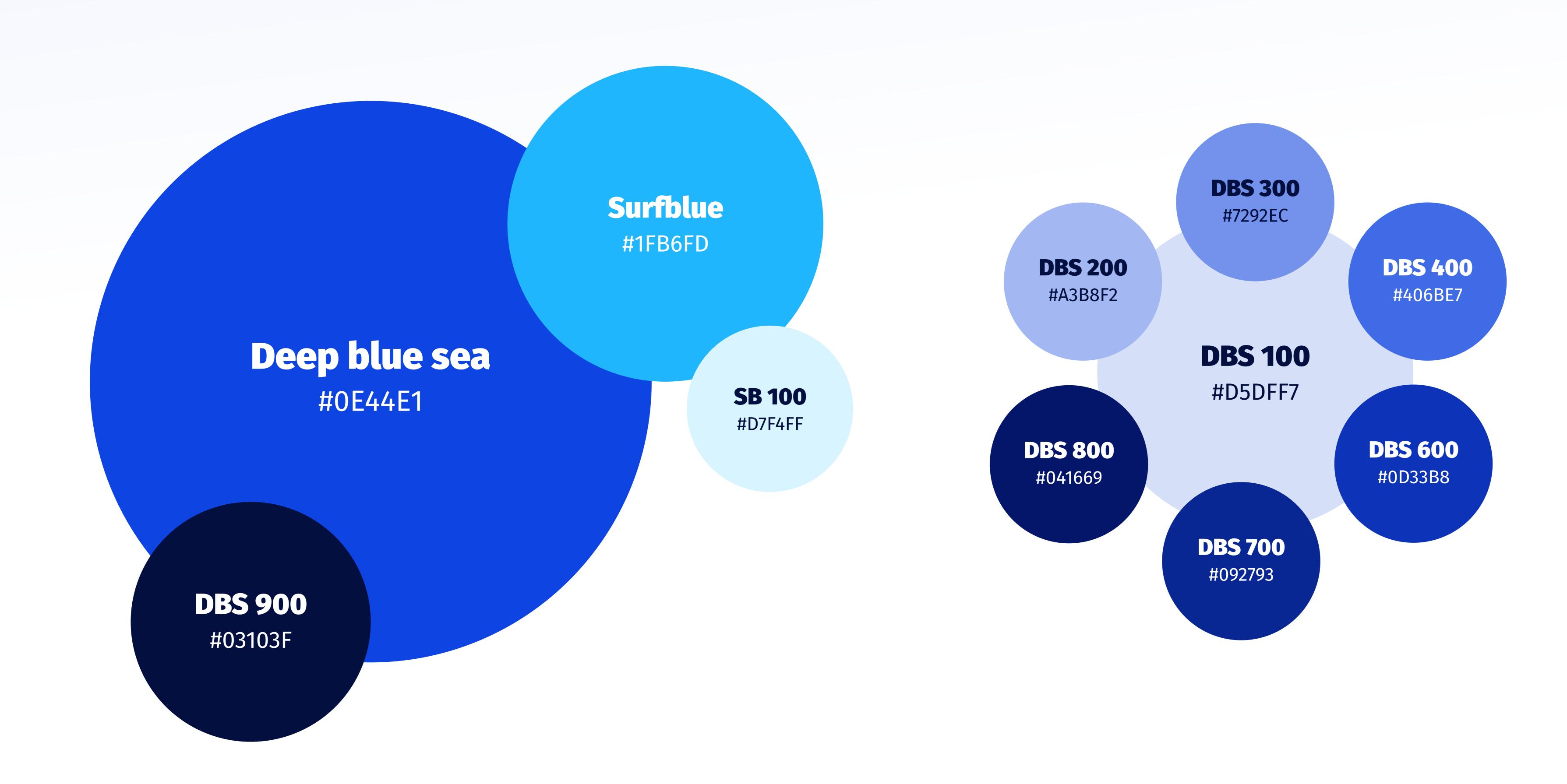
When using the logotype you need to consider which one. The logo-icon needs more spacing around to make sure it stands out since the logo-text is not there and therefore other brands could interfere with the illustration. At this point it will need 50% from both X-, and Y-axis. When using the full logotype you only need to consider the spacing around it to be minimum 25% of the logotypes height.





Color palette

To flirt with our Surfboarding brand the color scheme runs through the sea with our deep blue sea as the primary one. Each color goes in 1-9 scale which means that we can use different parts of each color to build our brand throughout any material and web usage.





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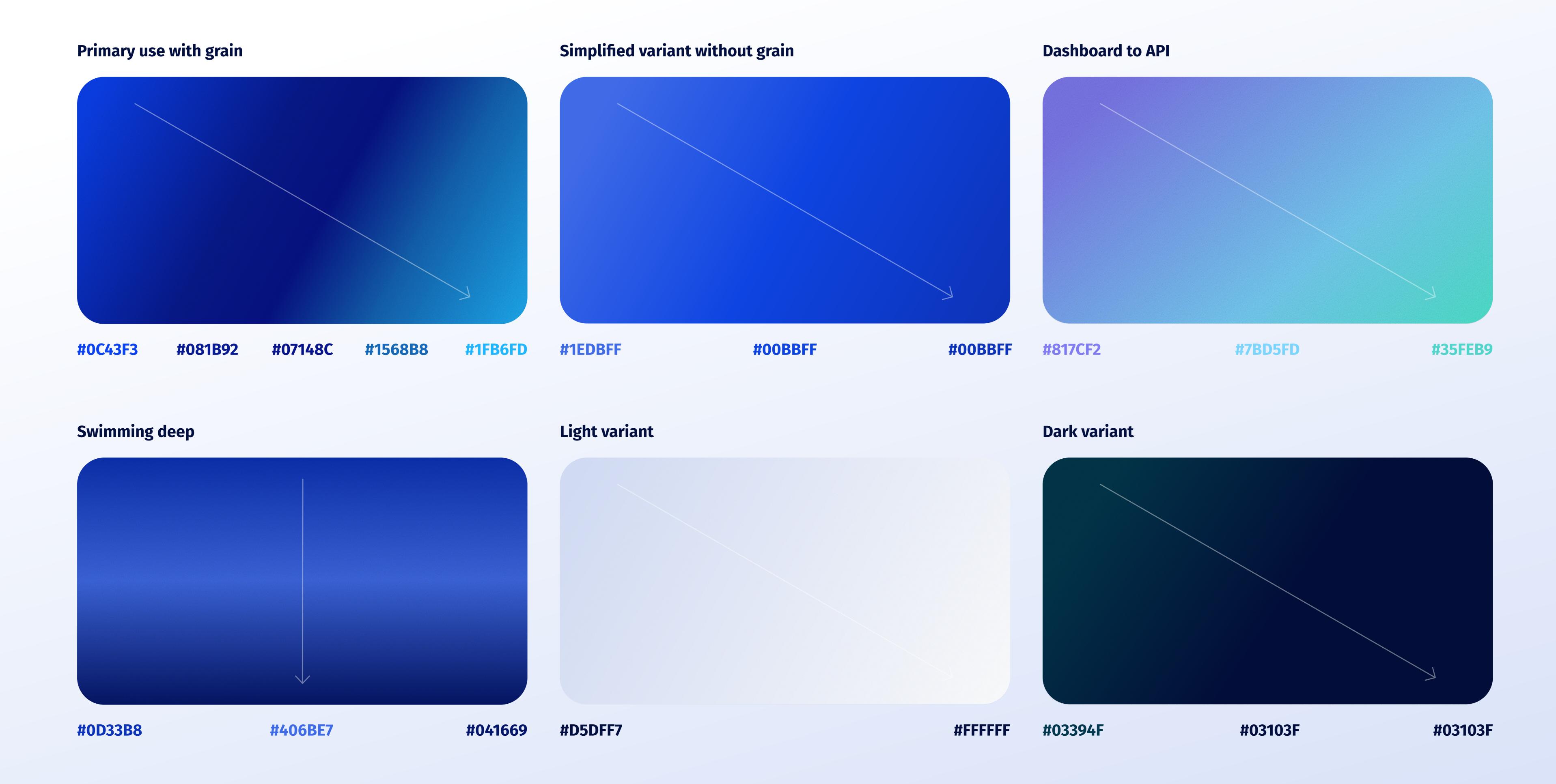

The headlines vary in size and weight based on context. The main headline can implement outlined text when it's possible to create a hierarchy within the sentence. The rem size is based on a body of 16px.

When it comes to the paragraph we primarily use the Regular weight, with additions from italic, bold and black.

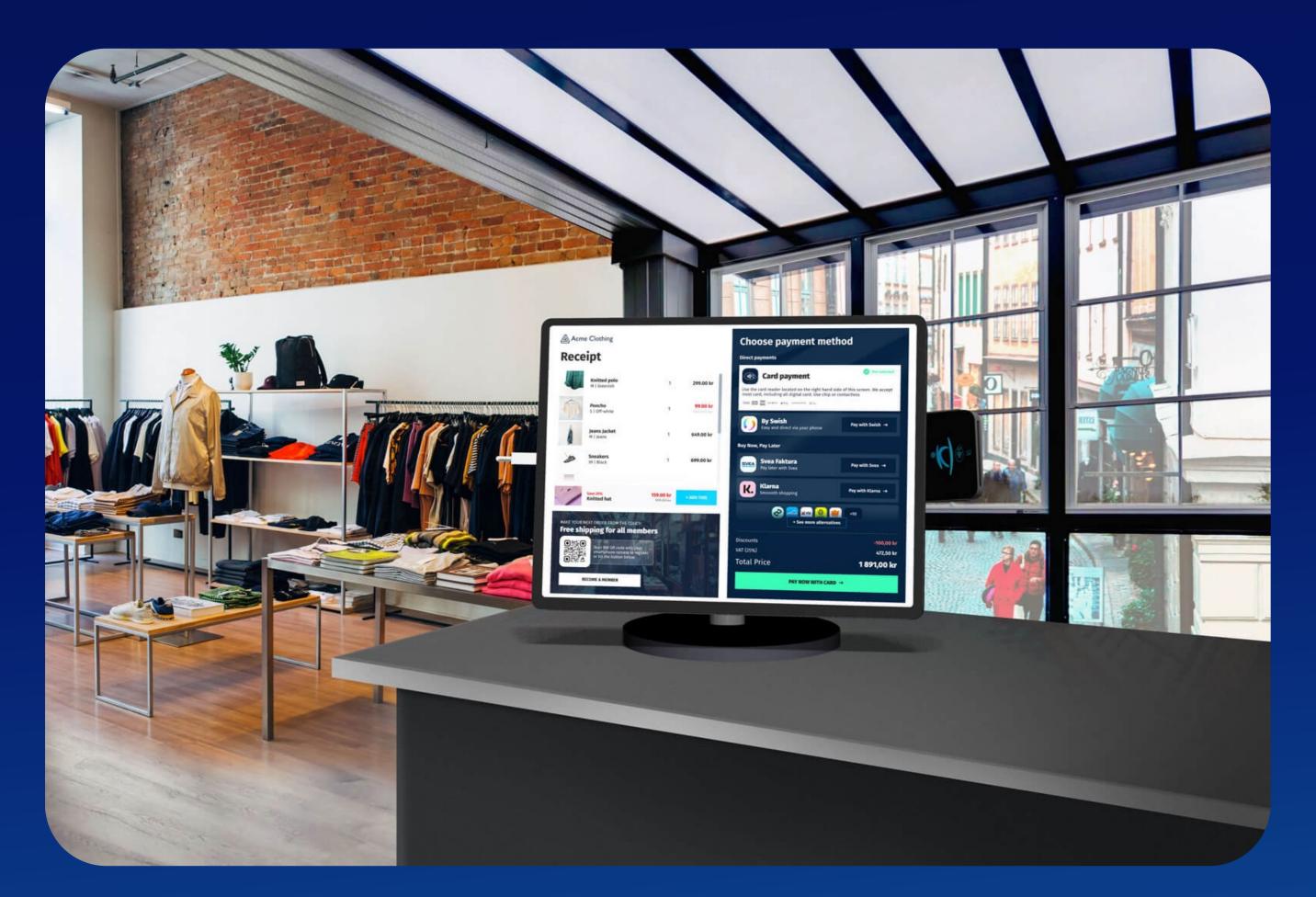

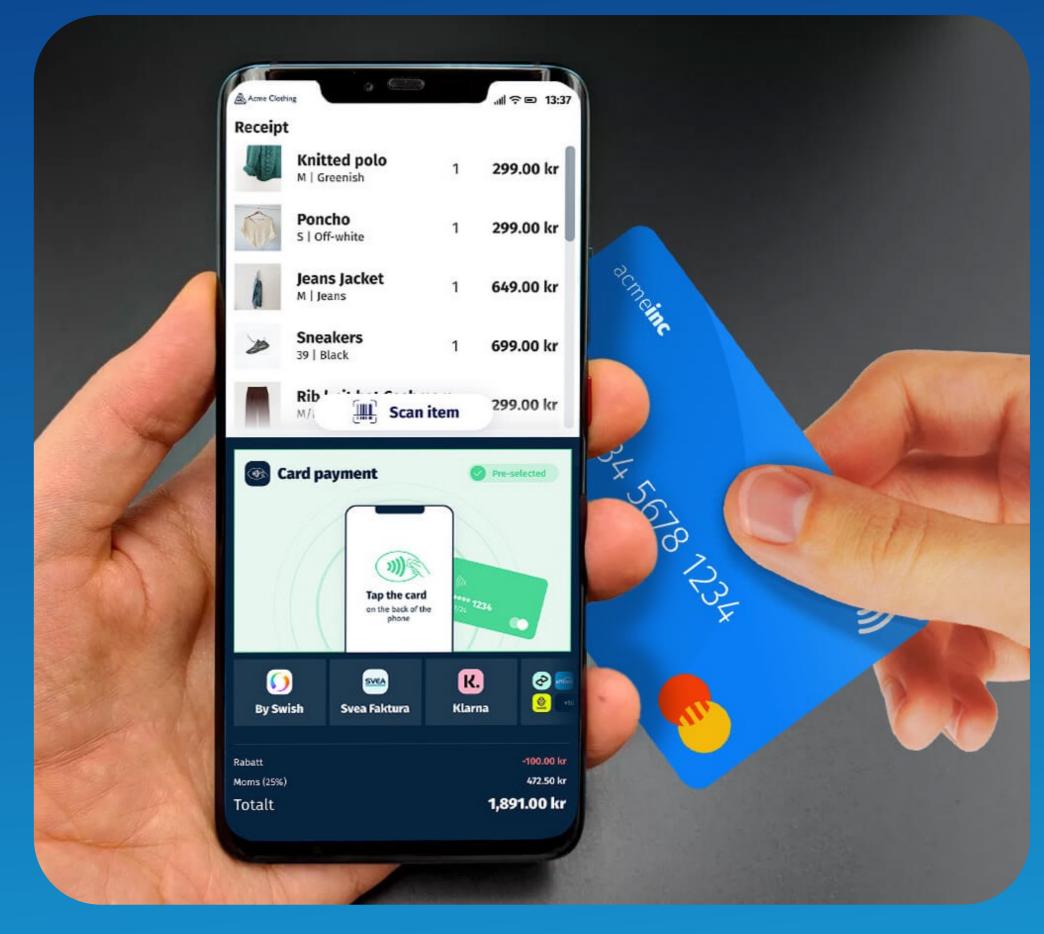












Icons & illustrative elements

We use icons in places where it lifts the content and have an impact on the user experience while illustrative elements are used to express the brand

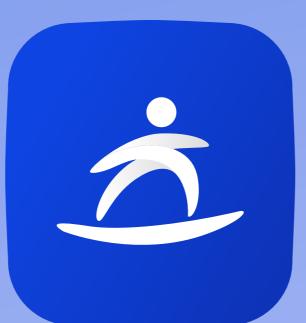

Uses gradient backgrounds from the color palette and rounded corners



















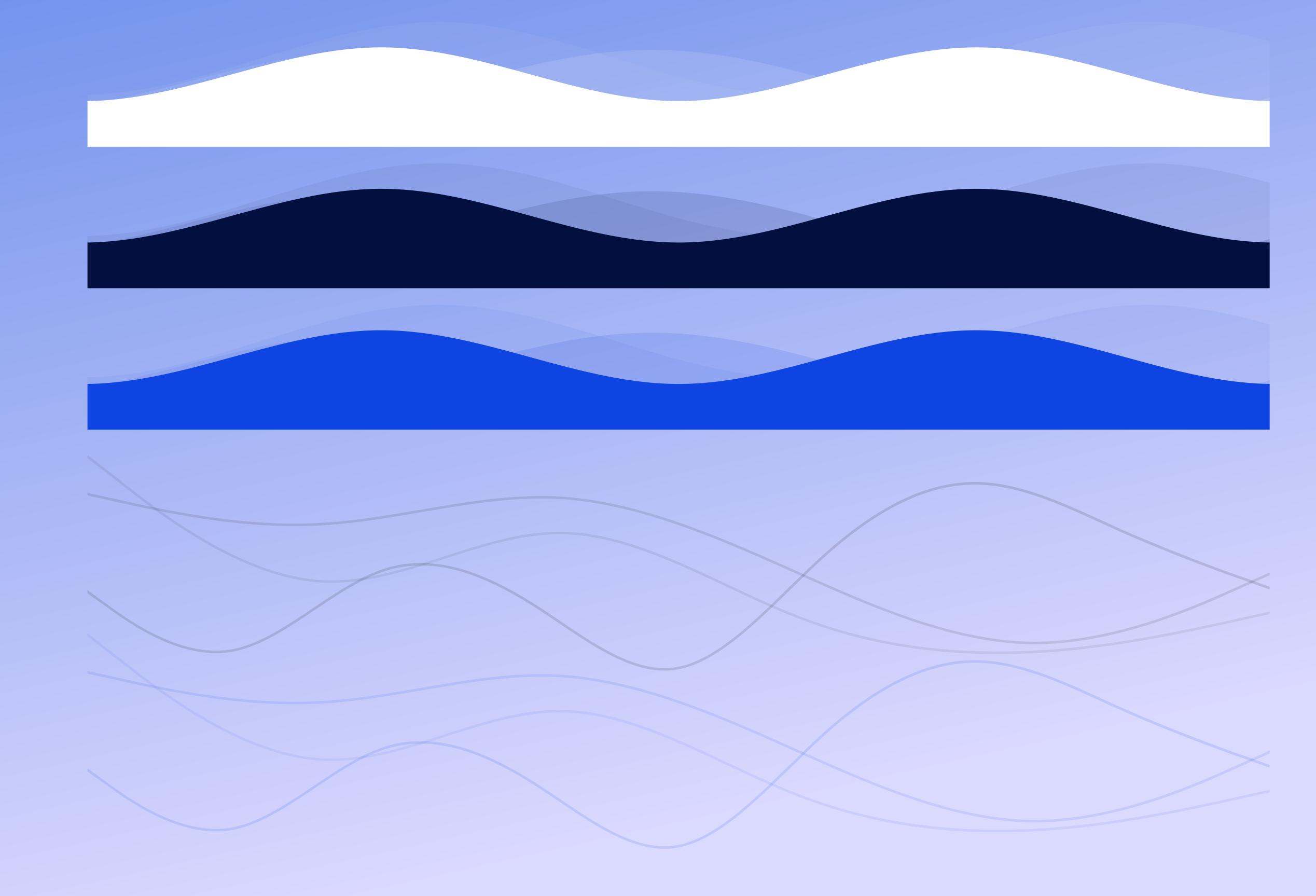
