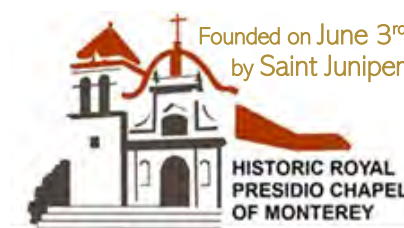

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER *by young-catholics.com*

The 4th Sunday of Easter Year A, known as Good Shepherd Sunday, highlights Jesus as the Good Shepherd who cares for His flock. The readings emphasize the themes of guidance, protection, and the call to follow Christ.

- **Jesus as the Good Shepherd:** Jesus calls Himself the Good Shepherd who knows His sheep and lays down His life for them. This image shows His deep care and willingness to sacrifice for us.
- **Repentance and Baptism:** In Acts, Peter calls for repentance and baptism in the name of Jesus. This theme emphasizes turning away from sin and beginning a new life in Christ.
- **Following Christ's Example:** Peter's letter urges us to follow Christ's example of suffering patiently. This teaches us to endure hardships with trust in God.
- **Hearing God's Voice:** Jesus says His sheep hear His voice and follow Him. This highlights the importance of listening to Jesus and discerning His guidance in our lives.
- **New Life in Christ:** Peter speaks of dying to sin and living for righteousness. This theme stresses the new life we receive through Christ's sacrifice and resurrection.

Conversion and Salvation: Acts recounts the conversion of many who heard Peter's message. This shows the power of the Gospel to change hearts and bring salvation. Good Shepherd Sunday reminds us of Jesus' care and guidance as our Shepherd. We are called to listen to His voice, follow Him, and live out our faith daily.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (YEAR A): SHEPHERD'S VOICES

The Easter Season is the Great 50 Days of celebration that begin on Easter Sunday and continue through the Sunday of Pentecost (a word which means "50"). All but one of the Sundays of the Easter Season draw their Gospel reading from the Gospel of St. John. This Sunday the Church invites us to recognize in the Risen Jesus our Good Shepherd who is the true Gate by which we enter eternal life as members of his Body. During the Easter Season too the First Reading is not from the Old Testament but from the Acts of the Apostles, St. Luke's account of the earliest days of the Church. The Second Reading for this Season is taken from the First Letter of Peter, inviting us to reflect on Peter's sermon on the morning of Pentecost. Throughout the Easter Season, all three readings are united by their single focus on Jesus, the Gate to the sheepfold, and the demands of living as beloved disciples whom Jesus calls by name and leads into life.

The Gospel John 10:1 - 10

Jesus assures us that he himself is "the Gate," the only true way to enter into the new life that Jesus brings us. Those who try to enter by any other gate can only be thieves and robbers. Using the "I AM" proclamation to reveal himself, Jesus establishes that he is both the shepherd and the gate for the sheep. Those sheep who truly belong to God will hear Jesus' voice and follow. Jesus provides access to God by being the Gate, the mediator between God and humanity. All those who enter through Jesus the Gate will have life and will have it abundantly, as Jesus promises in the last line of the Gospel.

The First Reading Acts of the Apostles 2:14a, 36 - 41

In his sermon on Pentecost morning, Peter converts many hearts to belief in Jesus whom "God has made both Lord and Christ." Peter encourages them to take the next steps: the first action is always repentance, the turning to Jesus for forgiveness and reconciliation. Then Baptism follows which is the gift of forgiveness of sins as well as the gift of the Holy Spirit. Many people that day heard the call of Jesus the Good Shepherd and entered into new life with him.

The Second Reading 1 Peter 2:20b - 25

The theme of Peter's preaching never varies: it is always Christ, whom the Jews crucified and whom God raised up. He is the Good Shepherd who is also the vulnerable lamb who endures all patiently so that evil and violence may be shown for what they really are – sins against God. Jesus our Shepherd is the source of our healing. We once strayed like lost sheep, but now we are safe in the care of the "shepherd and guardian of our souls."

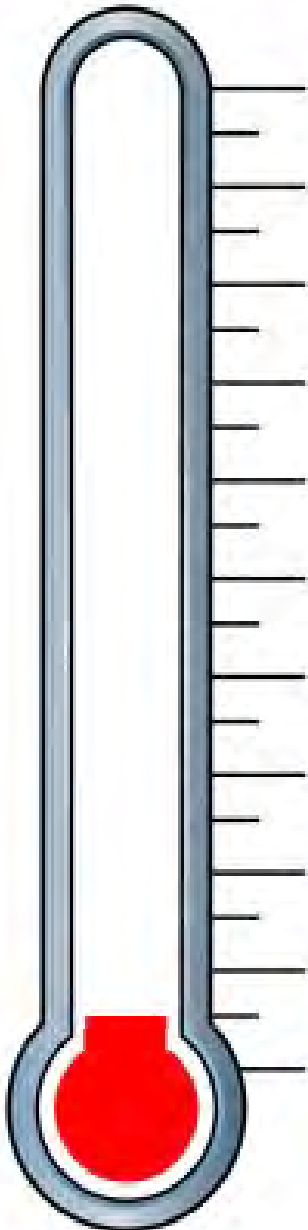

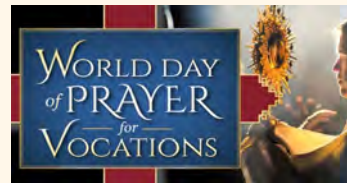

May we all be open to God's call in our own lives!

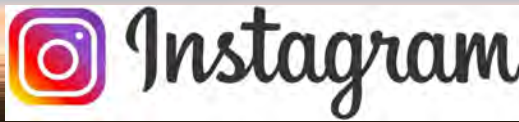
