

## The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A) by young-catholics.com

The 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A highlights Jesus as the light that leads people out of darkness. The readings show how God calls people to unity and invites them to follow Jesus.

- **Light in darkness:** Isaiah speaks of people walking in darkness who see a great light. Jesus brings this light by preaching and healing in Galilee.
- **Call to unity:** Paul urges the Corinthians to be united and not divided. Following Jesus means working together and not focusing on human leaders.
- **Jesus calls disciples:** Jesus calls Simon, Andrew, James, and John to follow Him. They leave everything behind to be with Him.
- **Repent and believe:** Jesus begins His preaching with a call to repentance. He invites people to change their ways and trust in God.
- **God's plan unfolds:** The prophecy in Isaiah is fulfilled in Jesus. His presence in Galilee shows that God's promises come true.
- **Spreading the good news:** Jesus goes from town to town preaching and healing. He shows that the message of God's kingdom is for everyone.

God brings light, calls people to follow Jesus, and asks for unity. The weekend, we are reminded to trust in God's plan.

# THE THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR A)

In 2019, Pope Francis declared the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time to be devoted “to the celebration, study, and dissemination of the Word of God.” He encouraged parishioners to strengthen our bonds with the Jewish people on this day as well as to pray for Christian Unity. He writes: “We urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen Lord who continues to speak through his Word and to break bread in the community of believers.” During this Third Week in Ordinary Time, our neighbor, St. Angela Merici Parish, celebrates their feast day on Tuesday, and the feast of the great Dominican saint, Thomas Aquinas, is Wednesday. Thursday we remember and pray for our previous Bishop, Daniel Garcia, (now Bishop of Austin), who was installed as the fifth Bishop of Monterey on that date in 2019. And finally, Saturday of this coming week we celebrate St. John Bosco, founder of the Salesian Order, known as the “Apostle of Youth.” Salesian Sisters run Salesian Elementary and Junior High Schools in Corralitos.

**The Gospel Matthew 4:12 - 23** The Sundays of Ordinary Time follow a three year cycle for the Gospel readings. This is Year A which has the Gospel of Matthew as its anchor, and the First Reading from the Old Testament is chosen to be in harmony with the Gospel. The Gospel readings during the Sundays of Ordinary Time begin with Chapter 4 of St. Matthew and then continue in order, offering us the most important readings, all the way to Chapter 25 at the end of Ordinary Time in November. Today we follow Jesus who is beginning his public ministry after John the Baptist was arrested. Jesus proclaims to all who listen: “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.” And he calls his first disciples – Simon, Andrew, James, and John, and challenges them to take up an entirely new mission; they will become fishers of people. The disciples’ immediate and whole-hearted response to Jesus prompts us to reflect on how we follow this same invitation. “He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed him.” May Jesus teach us too what it means to come after him and to fish for people in 2026 on the Monterey Peninsula.

**The First Reading Isaiah 8:23 – 9:3** Christians recognize that the Prophet Isaiah’s vision is fulfilled in the first events of Jesus’ public life. This passage from Isaiah relates to events connected to the invasion by the Assyrians of Northern Palestine in 732 BC. Isaiah sought to restore the people’s confidence: “The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light.” People desperate for rescue by a Messiah now see him coming in the person of Jesus; he is the light for everyone; he breaks the heavy yoke that has oppressed them. The words of the prophet sum up the whole mission of Jesus, and Matthew quotes these words to serve that purpose. The Light that is never overcome and the Good News are now being offered to us in our relationship with Jesus, our Savior and Lord.

**The Second Reading 1 Corinthians 1:10 – 13, 17** The Second Reading during the Sundays of Ordinary Time is completely independent of the Gospel and First Reading. The Church is intent on sharing with us key theological texts from St. Paul’s letters. Today we hear that St. Paul’s preaching of the Kingdom was built on the common union of believers, a union nourished and centered in the Eucharist. Paul is very sensitive to the lack of this unity, and addresses it here. It was clear that the Corinthians did not all share the same vision but were, in fact, hostile to one another. The divisions Paul has heard of are a basic contradiction to living the way of the Gospel and are a negation of the very being of the Church, Christ’s own Body.






