TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LOSE YOUR LIFE TO FIND IT *By Sr. Sharon Mcmillan*

The Gospel Matthew 16:21 - 27

What does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus Christ? Last Sunday's Gospel described St. Peter's experience of being praised by Jesus when Peter publicly professed his faith in Jesus as "the Christ, the Son of the Living God." Realizing the true identity of Jesus was not something that Peter figured out on his own; this divine truth was revealed to him by God. Today's Gospel continues the conversation between Jesus and Peter. Peter is convinced that, because Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah, his authority over the Jewish People should be a seamless experience of human glory and power and triumph. Peter assures Jesus that he will make sure that Jesus does not suffer any rejection or physical harm. What a shock it must have been for Peter to hear Jesus harshly condemn his attitude: "Get behind me, Satan!" Jesus insists that being Messiah means being the Suffering Servant, means being the one to give his life out of perfect love to lead every human being into the abundant life that is God's dream for each of us. It is precisely Jesus' death that leads to life and life eternal. The disciple then is to follow the path of the Master. Just as Jesus lays down his life in order to rise again, so each of his disciples, each baptized member of his Body, lives each day by dying and rising in Christ. We die to all within us that is not Jesus; we take up the cross he offers us, and we follow him, dying and rising with him every day until, after that final dying, we are raised up by him to live with him together with the Father and the Holy Spirit for ever. His cross is our path to true and full human life now and for ever.

First Reading Jeremiah 20:7 - 9

When Jeremiah was first called to be a prophet, he protested, saying he was too young. With a divine touch, Jeremiah was commanded by God to speak to the people despite his age: "See, I place my words in your mouth!" (a good description of what it means to be a prophet: one who speaks for God.)

When Jeremiah announced the coming destruction of Jerusalem and the exile that would follow, he was laughed at as a false prophet. When King Zedekiah refused to listen to Jeremiah's warnings, Jeremiah was close to despair. Obedience to God's Word had brought him nothing but suffering, so he vowed never to speak for God again. But God proved too strong for Jeremiah; God's Word could not be contained; it was like a raging fire within him. Amidst all the trials Jeremiah faced, God was with him, like a mighty warrior to defend the Prophet against his foes.

Second Reading Romans 12:1 - 2

In this section of Paul's Letter to the Romans, he is teaching the Christian community how to give praise to God in their new life in Christ. Believers have received mercy from God through Jesus; therefore their loving response should be praise and worship. Because they are no longer bound by the Law, which mandated a variety of sacrifices, they can offer their own bodies as acceptable sacrifices. Jesus himself set the example by offering himself on the Cross out of infinite love for each of us. Paul urges his community (and us) to imitate Jesus and not to conform ourselves to the standards of society.

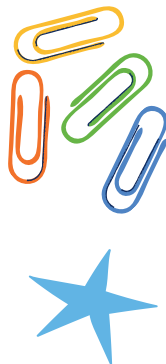

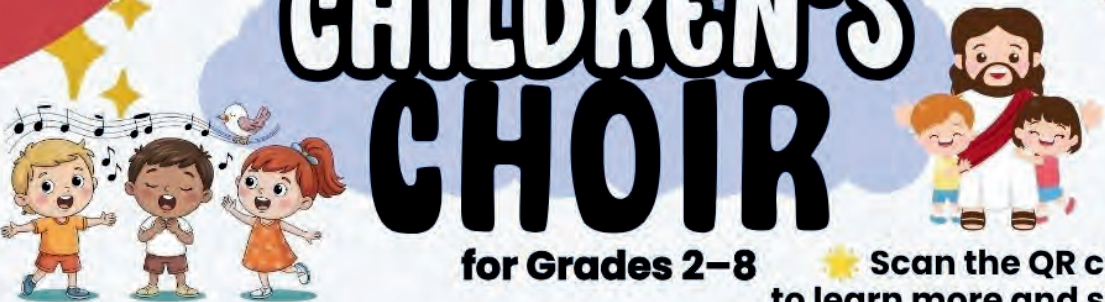
