TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: LIGHT, LIFE, LOVE

THE GOSPEL MATTHEW 18:15 - 20

This section of Matthew's Gospel presents steps to be taken in the life of the local community when one member sins against another. The first step is direct confrontation, begun by the one who is offended who approaches the other with a willingness to forgive (not with the attitude to condemn and punish). The best case scenario is that this first confrontation brings about the needed repentance, and then the deeply - desired mutual reconciliation results. If it fails, however, the next step is to involve one or two others from the community. The aim is to establish the truth, relying on impartial witnesses. If this approach does not work, then the matter is brought before the whole community. The term Matthew uses here for the community is the Greek word *ekklesia*, those people called together by God, the Church. If that fails, then the person is to be treated like "a Gentile or tax collector." The hope is that this exclusion of the person will bring them to their senses; they will wake up out of their selfish behavior and return to the life of the community. Note that the entire community in this process has a role in binding and loosing offenses, and the whole body is involved in praying for reconciliation for the member who went astray. When a single member of the Body of Christ is wronged, the whole community must be involved. The heavens rejoice when even one straying member returns to the community of faith.

FIRST READING EZEKIEL 33:7 - 9

This passage from the Book of the Prophet Ezekiel was chosen to be proclaimed this Sunday due to its close harmony with the words of today's Gospel. Ezekiel has been appointed by God to be the watchman for the house of Israel, to be the one who sees the sins of the people and speaks out against them. The watchman warns the wicked to turn away from their sins and then to return to the ways of God's holy people. God's deepest desire is that everyone who sins is awakened to the reality of their destructive choices by the voice of the watchman. Sinners then move away from their harmful actions; they literally "turn around" and choose the path of life in the company of the community. Today's Gospel outlines the process for this conversion to happen in the midst of the community of disciples.

SECOND READING ROMANS 13:8 - 10

The Second Reading throughout these long months of Ordinary Time is a passage that is independent of the Gospel and First Reading, so don't be surprised if it speaks of very different concerns. In today's reading, St. Paul asks the community to let the Gospel renew their minds to judge what is "good and pleasing and perfect" according to the will of God. Paul exhorts Christians to discern what is good for the Church, directing them to live in harmony with civil authority, but also to live in harmony with God's law. The heart of this instruction is the command to love one another as the fulfillment of the entire Law.
