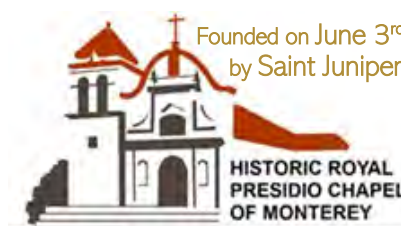

XVI SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A focuses on God's patience, mercy, and the growth of His kingdom. The readings show how God gives people time to change and how His kingdom grows in unexpected ways.

- **God's Justice and Mercy:** God is strong but also kind. He gives people time to turn back to Him instead of punishing them right away.
- **Patience in Growth:** The parable of the wheat and weeds teaches that good and bad exist together for now. God waits until the right time to separate them.
- **Power of Small Beginnings:** The mustard seed and yeast show that God's kingdom starts small but grows. What seems unimportant can have a big impact.
- **The Spirit's Help in Prayer:** The Holy Spirit helps when people do not know what to say in prayer. God understands even when words fail.
- **Hope for Repentance:** God does not rush to punish but gives people chances to change. He wants them to turn back to Him.
- **Trust in God's Timing:** The farmer in the parable waits for the right time to gather the harvest. God knows the right time to act in the world and in people's lives.

The 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A reminds people that God is patient and merciful. He gives time for growth and change, and His kingdom will grow in ways they may not expect.

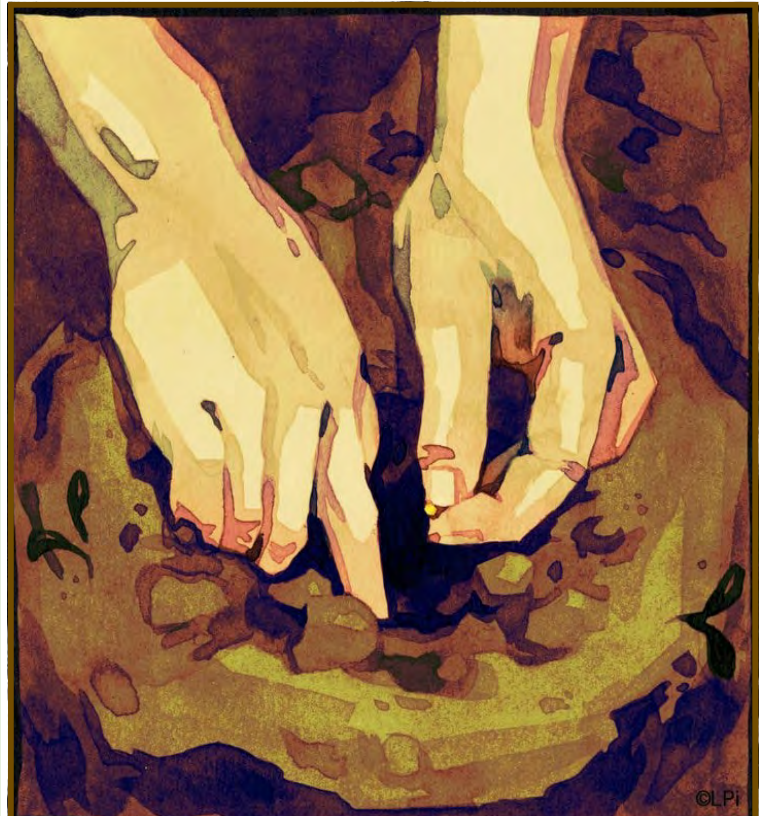

SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: *THE LORD OUR STRENGTH*

During this long months of Ordinary Time, we continue the same pattern for choosing the readings on Sunday. The Matthew's Gospel is the anchor of all these Sundays, presenting to us in order the most significant passages from that Gospel. The First Reading is chosen from the Old Testament to be in harmony with the Sunday's Gospel. The Second Reading is an independent reading, not related to either the Gospel or the First Reading. The Church chooses in the Second Readings to present key sections from the letters of St. Paul. The week ahead provides us with some powerful examples of "missionary disciples." The first is St. Mary Magdalene, known as the "apostle to the apostles," as she was commissioned by the Risen Jesus to proclaim his resurrection to the community of disciples. This Thursday we honor the great saint of Lebanon, St. Sharbel Makhlof. During this time of war and violence that overwhelms Lebanon, we pray to him to bring Christ's own peace for the people. This Saturday is the Feast of St. James, apostle, brother of John, the first of the Twelve to be martyred. He is also patron of pilgrims, of Spain, Guatemala, and Nicaragua.

The Gospel Matthew 13:24 - 43

Three parables are presented in this passage, highlighting the parable of the weeds and the wheat. Jesus stresses that God is just and allows the wicked to live along with the good until the time of final judgment, when justice will reign. Jesus reveals to the people the amazing power of the kingdom of God. Just as the tiny mustard seed grows into a large bush, creating a home for a countless diversity of birds, and just as a tiny bit of yeast leavens the whole batch, providing bread to feed many, just so the kingdom of God grows and expands by our acts of forgiveness and concern for others. By our Baptism, we have become the good seed Jesus sows in the world, relying on him to bring about his harvest of justice and peace for all the world. Holy Spirit, make us courageous in this task you have given us!

First Reading Wisdom 12:13, 16 - 19

The Book of Wisdom was written about 50 years before Christ. In one lengthy section of this book, the author looks back to the wonderful things God did for the Jewish people at the time of the Exodus. In today's passage from that section, we hear the author speak directly to God with words of praise. As "master of might," God judges "with clemency, and with much lenience." By modeling how power is to be exercised, God teaches people "That those who are just must be kind." God is our strength and hope because we know that whenever God's might is at work, it is always exercised with kindness and forgiveness.

Second Reading Romans 8:26 - 27

We continue to hear from the 8th chapter of St. Paul's Letter to the Romans. In this brief section, Paul offers insights into the role of the Holy Spirit in our prayer. He asserts, that, as human beings, we are weak and fallible, resulting in our inability to pray "as we ought." Being linked to Jesus through our baptismal call, however, we are gifted with the Holy Spirit who intercedes for us.

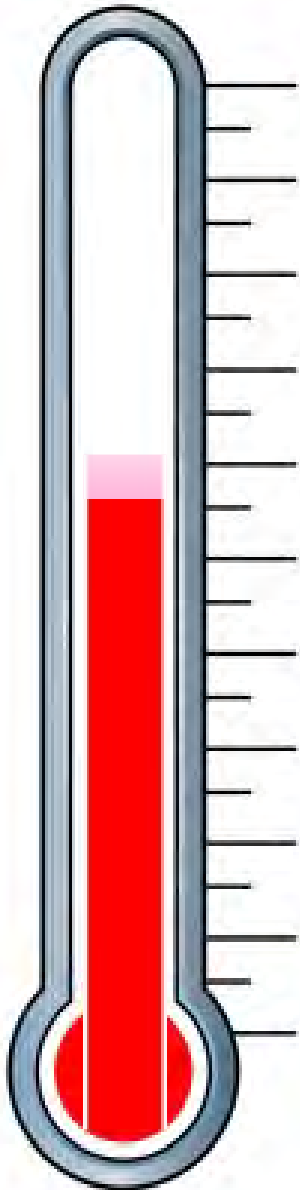

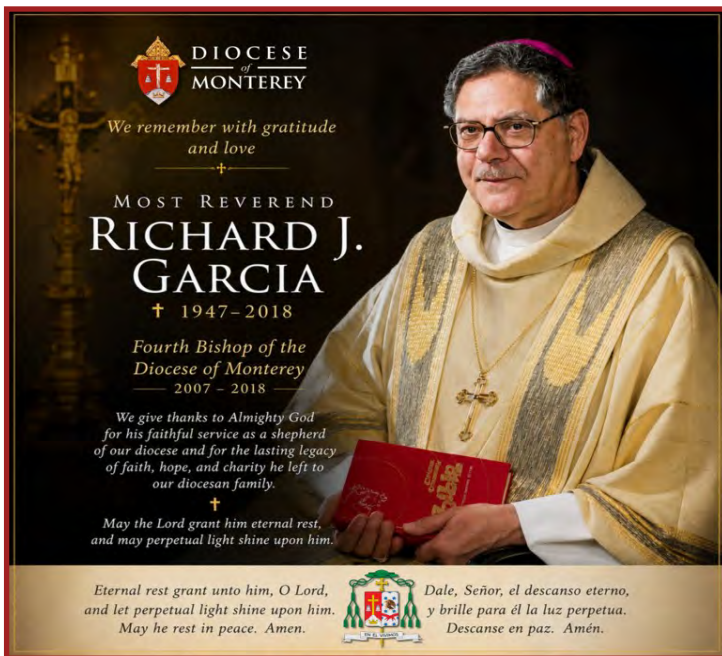

 Therefore, with the help of God, I now dedicate myself to the task of being all the things that I want my parish to be. **Amen.**

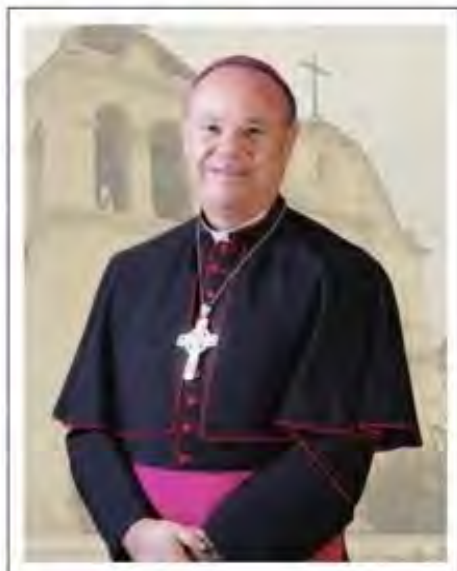
