#### Introduction

### A reading from the Gospel of Luke

The disciples were talking about how beautiful the temple was but in this reading Jesus reminded them that one day the temple would no longer be there. This helps us to remember that our church is more than just a building. It is the people that make the church. We are also reminded that the kingdom of God is not a building.

Help us to respond to the challenges of our times in new ways to bring your love to all our sisters and brothers. We make this prayer through Jesus Christ Our Lord.




