The KIEP endeavors to increase innovation and productivity in select private sector firms in Kenya and will be implemented over a period of six (6) years. The State Department for Industrialization requires to hire an individual consultant as a Project Manager. This individual will manage the project, including oversight as well as designing, running, and monitoring the project's technical and administrative work as part of KIEP's Project Implementation Unit.

- A Bachelor's degree in Economics, Business or comparable degree, (a Master's degree in a related field would be an added advantage)
- Strong analytical, technical writing and public presentation skills.
- Proven project management skills, including planning, coordinating, monitoring and reporting.

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- Minimum 10 years of professional experience in Project Management, in a top leadership capacity out of which at least 3 years are in Coordinating/implementing economic development projects.
- Strong stakeholder communication skills.
- Proven ability to work with partners including donors, bilateral organizations and governments, (preferably with 4 years' experience on donor funded projects)
- Proven ability to operate effectively and independently with minimum supervision.
