ANALYSIS OF EXISTING POLICIES ON MANUFACTURE OF MEDICAL DEVICES IN KENYA

Specifically this will include identification of existing policy frameworks, identification of key institutions and their role in regulating the manufacture of medical devices and an analysis of the gaps in the policy environment (technical, human resource, financial, research and development, infrastructure, supply chain). S/he is also expected to identify and assess the existing policies for enhanced private sector engagement in local manufacture of medical devices and finally develop external stakeholders' engagement framework with clear timelines and milestones based on the gaps identified.
