

# Proposal: Free TON SC Jury Global Selection

## Description

Create a decentralized jury consisting of members of the Free TON community with proven expertise of development. SC Jury Global members will spend time and effort on analyzing, evaluating and providing qualified feedback to participants of Contests.

This Jury Group does not and won't ever bound to any of the existing Free TON SG or Givers. Instead, any SG or Main Governance members may indicate that SC Group members can vote for submissions of given Contest. To do that, both forum and on-chain version of Contest Proposal should:

- be tagged with **#SmC** tag;
- include sections describing the tokens allocation, evaluation and reward distribution criteria for Jury from SC Group.

## Type

Contest.

## Contest period

Begins 17-03-2021 at 00:00:00 UTC

Ends 25-03-2021 at 23:59:59 UTC.

## Voting for a new jury

- Each juror of the Free TON SC initial jury group should vote by rating each submission on a scale of 1 to 10 or can choose to reject it if it does not meet the contest requirements. A juror may vote as “abstain” only in exceptional cases.
- Jurors must provide feedback on all of the submissions.

## Procedural remarks

- Participants must correctly upload their application to the Free TON Jury Global Selection contest (in PDF format) in order for the initial jury group to view it. If the application is not available or does not meet the described criteria, the candidate will be rejected by the initial jury group.
- Participants must submit their work before the end of the contest duration. If the application is submitted late, it will not be accepted.
- A submission must contain the contestant's details as follows:
