

Regulations PADEL CHAMPIONSHIP BASEL Vol. VI

Venues

The tournament will take place on the following courts:

- Union Padel Hafen (main venue)
 Uferstrasse 70, 4057 Basel
- Padel Basel Klybeck

- Padel Basel Dreispitz
 Lyon-Strasse 11, 4053 Basel
- Padel Social Club Basel

Schedule

- Saturday, November 1st
 Group stage
 Matches will be held between 9 AM and 9 PM at the participating clubs' courts.
- Sunday, November 2nd
 Quarter-finals, semi-finals, final, and third-place match
 Matches will take place between 2 PM and 8 PM at the courts of Union Padel
 Hafen.
- The match times for each team will be drawn after the registration deadline. Once that's done, all teams will be informed by email.

Categories

- Rookie PT Level up to 2
- Advanced PT Level 2 3.5

Guidelines for Category Selection

- Players with a lower PT level are allowed to compete in a higher category.
- Players with a higher PT level are not allowed to compete in a lower category.
- The determining factor is the average PT level of both players, with the PT level of the higher-rated player permitted to exceed the maximum level of the selected category by up to 0.5 points.
- A manual, negative level adjustment is allowed up to 30 days before the tournament. If a level adjustment is made after this deadline, the last level prior to the adjustment will be applied.

Format

- Each category has four groups with four teams each.
- Every team plays against every other team in its group once.
- The top two teams from each group advance to the quarter-finals.
- If fewer than 16 teams register per category, the organising committee reserves the right to adjust the format.

Team Allocation

- The 8 teams with the highest average Playtomic level in their category will be evenly distributed among the four groups. The remaining 8 teams will be randomly assigned.
- Note: Players without a PT level will be randomly assigned. Self-assessment is not possible.

Match Format

- Each match consists of two sets.
- If the score is 1:1 (all), a tiebreak is played. To decide the match, a team needs at least 7 points with a lead of two points.
- If the score is 40:40 (deuce), a Golden Point is played to decide a game. The receiving team can choose on which side of the court they want to receive the serve.

Cancellation

• Cancellations are possible at any time. The registration fee will be refunded minus a cancellation fee of CHF 10 per team.
