



Games Programme Codes of Conduct

Recruitment Staff

All scouts are expected to:

- Familiarise themselves with all information provided by the Premier League prior to the event
- Always present Photo ID on arrival as well as any registration ticket/code
- Always wear accreditation given to them for the duration of the event/fixture
- Conduct themselves in a respectful manner that reflects professionalism and integrity
- Behave responsibly and never engage in or tolerate the use of offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour. Set a good example!
- Always conduct themselves in a manner that takes all reasonable measures to protect their own safety and the safety of others
- Respect and work with the event staff adhering to guidance, messaging, and following instructions when applicable
- Not access unauthorised areas e.g. changing rooms, player accommodation, etc
- They do not enter the field of play
- Maintain personal boundaries and do not approach participating Children, and parents/guardians of participating children
- Never take photos of children participating
- Be aware that filming is not permitted
- Always adhere to health and safety guidelines
- Their attention is drawn to instructions, safety briefings and arrangements. They know what instructions to follow in the event of an emergency
- Not smoke or vape, consume alcohol (including branded alcohol-free drinks) at the site venue and around participants throughout the event
- Report any concerns to Premier League event staff without delay

Breaches of These Codes of Conduct

The Premier League reserves the right to determine appropriate disciplinary action for breaches of these codes of conduct. This may include being asked to leave the Tournament and being excluded from future events. Any breaches will be followed up with the respective Club.
