


Day 0 | Delhi - Shimla

- · Get ready to be departed from Delhi by Evening
- Reach Shimla next morning by an overnight Volvo.









Day 01 | Shimla To Chitkul/Sangla

Shimla – Kufri- Narkanda – Karcham Dam – Sangla - Chitkul

- We will reach Shimla in morning around 8:30 AM.
- The Spiti Expedition journey starts from here.
- Long drive through the scenic beauty of Kinnaur via Narkanda and Rampur.
- Travel along the Sutlej river till Karcham.
- Arrive Chitkul/Sangla in the evening and enjoy at the stay for night.

Distance Covered: 240-260 Kms Travel Time: 08-09 Hrs







Day 02 | Chitkul to Tabo


Chitkul - Sangla - Nako - Tabo

- After Breakfast, spend some time at leisure and check out.
- Chitkul is the last Indian village towards China border.
 Explore the best of it. Next, you will be departing For Tabo
 Enroute Nako Lake.
- Passing by Spiti River, enjoy 360-degree view of the mesmerising mountains. Reach Tabo, by evening, check-in to your stay and have dinner.

Distance Covered: 233-260 Kms Travel Time: 09-10 Hrs







Day 03 | Tabo to Kaza


Tabo - Dhankar - Pin Valley - Kaza

- After having breakfast spend some peaceful time at the beautiful Tabo Monastery and know different stories by the Monks.
- Time to head toward the beautiful administrative town of Spiti Valley, Kaza.
- Explore the oldest monastery of the valley in Dhankar.
- During this excursion, you will be confronted to Pin Valley, a house to wonderful verdure of the high Himalayas.
- Enter the exquisite town and stay in Kaza.

Distance Covered: 90-120 Kms Travel Time: 05-06 Hrs







Day 04 | Kaza

Hikkim - Komic - Langza - Kaza

- Divine Spiti Valley sightseeing awaits you after having breakfast.
- At 4,400m above sea level in, the Hikkim post office is a vital connection to the outside world.
- Send postcards to friends and family.
- Visit Komic Gompa at the World's Highest motor-able village and have a delicious lunch.
- Langza is a high- altitude village known for ancient marine fossils. Collect some fossils to take memories of nature home

Distance Covered: 50-60 Kms Travel Time: 03-05 Hrs







Day 05 | Kaza | Key Monastery | Kibber Chicham Bridge

- Visit the spectacular Tibetan Buddhist Key Monastery located on a hilltop at an altitude of 4,166 meters above the sea level.
- Visit Kibber, a town that is an extremely continuous objective for snow panthers to visit.
- Chicham Bridge is the highest bridge in Asia and allows you to have panoramic views.

Distance Covered: 40-60 Kms Travel Time: 03-05 Hrs







Day 06 | Kaza to Kalpa

Kaza – Giu Mummy – Nako - Kalpa

- After breakfast, start the return journey.
- Pay a visit to over 500- years- old Tibetan mummy in Giu village.
- Sightseeing at the Nako River and explore Nako top.
- Reach Kalpa by late- evening, go through some last valuable time with your new travel amigos.

Distance Covered: 230-250 Kms Travel Time: 07-08 Hrs





Day 07 | Kalpa to Shimla to Delhi

- Wake up to the Kinner Kailash view.
- Visit the popular Suicide point and start your excursion back to Shimla.
- Reach Shimla by evening. Depart for Delhi.
- Arrive in Delhi next morning i.e., 8th Day.

Distance Covered: 228-250 Kms Travel Time: 7.5-09 Hrs

- ✓ Sightseeing by Tempo Traveler/ 4X4 Gypsy/ 4X4 Kemper (Note as per price mentioned in package)

 - 1 Night at Chitkul/Sangla
 - 1 Night at Nako/Tabo,
 - 3 Nights in Kaza
 - 1 Night at Kalpa
- ✓ Meals (6 Breakfasts and 6 Dinner) only in Stay's.
- ✓ Team Leader throughout the trip.
- ✓ All applicable toll, parking and driver charges.
- ✓ All inner line permits.

- ✓ Oxygen cylinder and medical kit to handle extreme situations.
- ✓ Driver allowances, toll taxes, parking, state taxes
- ✓ Our ground operations team is also available in Chitkul, Tabo, Kaza and Kalpa.

Exclusions

- Travel or medical insurance and Any medical emergency
- Winter clothing of any kind.
- Hotel transport and other costs added to the trip, in addition to proposed plan due to road blockage, snowfall, political unrest or landslide, Health reason, has to be paid on actual basis, by participants.
- Anything else not mentioned in the inclusions.
- Cost incurred due to change in itinerary due to landslides, roadblocks or factors beyond human control.
- The package doesn't include the cost of any form of insurance, rescue, evacuation, hospitalisation and entry tickets.
- 5% GST if applicable
- Other expenses such as drinks and tips are not included.
- Any additional expenses such as of personal nature.
 Additional accommodation/food costs incurred due to any delay travel.
- Any lunch and other meals not mentioned in Package Inclusions.
- Any Airfare / Rail fare other than what is mentioned in "Inclusions" or any type of transportation.
- Parking and monument entry fees during sightseeing.

Important Information

- ✓ Winter in Spiti is harsh and temperatures are known to plummet to lesser than -10 degrees Celsius at night. Winter travel in Spiti is all about cold, (brrr.colder) and coldest.
- ✓ Equipment: Back Pack/Rucksack 50 to 60 litres, Head torch or Torch-1 nos. and Water bottle 1L- 2 nos.
- ✓ Footwears: Trekking/Hiking boots/ Snow boots, Floaters/ Sleepers- 1 pair, Sports/ trekking socks – 4 pair and Woolen socks - 2 pair
- ✓ Clothing: Down jacket— 1nos. (Comfortable till -15 temp), Pants 2 -3 nos (Winter woolen trek pants), T shirts 3nos, Fleece 2 nos (woolen fleece), Gloves-1 Nos (Waterproof woolen gloves), Sun cap- 1 Nos, Woolen Cap 1 nos (carry one cap extra for layering), Neck Warmer/bandana 1 nos (woolen bandana), Quick Dry Napkin/Towel 1 nos and Undergarments 3 to 4 pairs and Thermal inner wear 2 Pair
- ✓ Miscellaneous: Toiletries, Toilet paper (Wet Tissues), Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Facewash
- ✓ Petroleum Jelly, Cold creams and Sun- screen SPF 40 etc
- ✓ First Aid medical Kit: (Medication for common disorders i.e.cold, fever, Diarrhea, vomits etc, Crepe bandage, Stick band aid, ORS, glucose, instant pain relief spray i.e Volini, Relispray etc and personal medication if any)

Payment Policy

- ✓ Booking amount is INR 5,000/- Per seat.
- ✓ Booking is done on first come first serve basis.
- ✓ Rest of the amount is to be paid 20 days before the trip. (Through Bank Transfer)
- ✓ Booking amount is Non Refundable.

Cancellation Policy

- ✓ If cancellations are made 30 days prior the departure date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fee.
- ✓ If cancellations are made 15-30 days prior the departure date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fee.
- ✓ If cancellations are made 0-15 days prior the departure date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fee.

Important Information

- ✓ Trip schedule is subjected to change as per road, weather and other unavoidable conditions so take a day or two in buffer. This is not an ordinary place its "Spiti".
- ✓ Only Team members have the right to take decision depending on above.
- ✓ Any extra cost (Transportation/Accommodation) arising due to natural calamities like, landslides, road blockage, political disturbances or change in law will be extra.
- ✓ Any stay apart from fixed schedule (as per the itinerary) will be extra.
- ✓ The itinerary is subject to favourable weather and road conditions. In case of a bad weather and inaccessibility to certain destinations we will try our best to make alternate plans. Though we do not consider refunds, but we will reconsider it on case to case basis. We will try to refund you as much as we can if the tour gets cancelled before the 3rd day of your tour, depending on the cancellation charges levied to us by hotels/homestays.
- ✓ The temperatures in Spiti Valley dip up to 20°C in winters. We advise the clients to buy suitable clothing and gear for winters. People of Spiti live in this place throughout the year without expensive warm wear so there is nothing to be afraid of. The homestays are well insulated with a traditional/electric heater. The homestays will have dry compost toilets in winter.
- ✓ Most hotels will be closed in Spiti during winters, only homestays will be available. At other places we will provide you hotels. We will provide you heated rooms at Homestays in Spiti and at hotels in other places. Homestays will have common dry pit compost.
