Startups- Process and Challenges

Vivekananda School of Information Technology organized a Webinar on "Startups- Process and Challenges" on 05th March 2022. The guest speaker was Mr. Prem Kumar Mishra, who is the Director of MHV Media OPC Private Limited. The event was attended by 51 students and faculty members. The objective was to explain to students how startup works, the process of starting a startup, and the challenges faced by the startups. The speaker explained how regular companies duplicate what's been done before. A prospective restaurant owner may franchise an existing restaurant. So, they work from an existing template of how a business should work. While a Startup aims to create an entirely new template. Another key factor that distinguishes startups from other companies, is speed and growth. Startups aim to build on ideas very quickly. They often do this through a process called iteration, in which they continuously improve products through feedback and usage data. While enhancing their products, startups are also generally looking to rapidly expand their customer base. This helps them establish increasingly larger market shares, which in turn lets them raise more money and let them grow their products and audience even more. The Speaker also talked about the challenges that a STARTUP face. He mentioned the Challenges such as Lack of Risk-Taking, Financing, Insufficiency of talent, etc. There was a Q&A section too in which students asked some interesting questions namely: How to look for good investors for our startup? What is the greatest risk in starting a startup? Business innovation is important or customer need? What happened if a startup failed? How to recover that? What action can be performed next?
